Abolition Of White Democracy:

The Abolition of White Democracy Joel Olson, 2004 Racial discrimination embodies inequality exclusion and injustice and as such has no place in a democratic society And yet racial matters pervade nearly every aspect of American life influencing where we live what schools we attend the friends we make the votes we cast the opportunities we enjoy and even the television shows we watch Joel Olson contends that given the history of slavery and segregation in the United States American citizenship is a form of racial privilege in which whites are equal to each other but superior to everyone else In Olson s analysis we see how the tension in this equation produces a passive form of democracy that discourages extensive participation in politics because it treats citizenship as an identity to possess rather than as a source of empowerment Olson traces this tension and its disenfranchising effects from the colonial era to our own demonstrating how after the civil rights movement whiteness has become less a form of standing and more a norm that cements while advantages in the ordinary operations of modern society To break this pattern Olson suggests an abolitionist democratic political theory that makes the fight against racial discrimination a prerequisite for expanding democratic participation

Race and Police Ben Brucato, 2023-09-15 In the United States race and police were founded along with a capitalist economy dependent on the enslavement of workers of African descent *Race and Police* builds a critical theory of American policing by analyzing a heterodox history of policing drawn from the historiography of slavery and slave patrols Beginning by tracing the historical origins of the police mandate in British colonial America the book shows that the peculiar institution of racialized chattel slavery originated along with a novel binary conception of race On one side for the first time Europeans from various nationalities were united in a single racial category Inclusion in this category was necessary for citizenship On the other Blacks were branded as slaves cast as social enemies and assumed to be threats to the social order The state determined not only that it would administer slavery but that it would regulate slaves authorizing the use of violence by agents of the state and white citizens to secure the social order In doing so slavery citizenship and police mutually informed one another and together they produced racial capitalism a working class defined and separated by the color line and a racial social order *Race and Police* corrects the Eurocentrism in the orthodox history of American police and in predominating critical theories of police That orthodoxy rests on an origin story that begins with Sir Robert Peel and the London Metropolitan Police Service Predating the Met by more than a century America s first police often called slave patrols did more than maintain order it fabricated a racial order Prior to their creation all white citizens were conscripted to police all Blacks Their participation in the coercive control of Blacks gave definition to their whiteness Targeted as threats to the security of the economy and white society being policed defined Blacks who for the first time were treated as a single racial group The boundaries of whiteness were first established on the basis of who was required to regulate slaves given a specific mandate to prevent Black insurrection a mandate that remains core to the police role to this day

revolts against and flight from America Other people have written on Wright s revolutionary heroes his difficulties with the FBI and his works as a postcolonial provocateur but none have focused singly on his treatment of America Wherever Wright traveled he always positioned himself as an African American as he compared his experiences to those at hand However as his domestic settlements changed to international residences Wright s craftsmanship changed as well To convey his cultural message Wright created characters themes and plots that would expose arbitrary and whimsical American policies oppressive rules which would invariably ensnare Wright s protagonists and sink them more deeply into the quagmire of racial subjugation as they grasped for a fleeting moment of freedom Smith s collection brings to the fore new ways of looking at Wright particularly his post *Native Son* international writings Indeed no critical interrogations have considered the full significance of Wright s masterful crime fictions In addition the author s haiku poetry complements the fictional pieces addressed here reflecting Wright s attitude toward America as he near the end of his life searched for nirvana his antidote to American racism

Excluded Within Sina Kramer, 2017 Why are some claims seen or heard as political claims while others are not Why are some people not seen or heard as political agents And how does their political unintelligibility shape political bodies and the terms of political agency from which they are excluded In this groundbreaking book Sina Kramer uses the framework of constitutive exclusion to describe the phenomenon of internal exclusion exclusions that occur within a political body More specifically constitutive exclusions occur when a system of thought or a political body defines itself by excluding some difference based on gender race class sexuality etc that is considered intolerable to the boundaries that comprise the body or system s political worth This exclusion is not absolute but preserves the very difference it seeks to repress in order to define itself against what it is not Yet as Kramer argues if those who are excluded contest their repression their political claims are deemed threatening and criminal But can we ever be without constitutive exclusions And can we avoid reinscribing them through critique Kramer ultimately argues that to do justice to the excluded to render those claims intelligible as political claims instead requires the reconstitution of the political body on new terms Importantly this book offers both a diagnosis and a critique of the concept of constitutive exclusion articulating what counts as a political

action and who counts as a political agent Kramer takes up a range of cases including those of Antigone Claudette Colvin and Rosa Parks the 1992 Los Angeles riots and the Black Lives Matter movement to better understand who counts as a political actor and how we understand political belonging and the contestation of exclusion Excluded Within articulates who we are by virtue of who we exclude and what claims we cannot see hear or understand
