

Re-viewing Augustan culture

KARL GALINSKY, *AUGUSTAN CULTURE: AN INTERPRETIVE INTRODUCTION* (Princeton University Press, 1996). Pp. 474, 164 pls., 10 figs., 8 col. pls. ISBN 0-691-04435-X. \$39.50.

The reign of Rome's first emperor Augustus has been a source of perpetual fascination and debate for the 20th c., and Karl Galinsky's magisterial synoptic study stands as a significant milestone in its ongoing discussion. Weaving together his own writings on the poetry and monuments of the age, as well as the work of a myriad of other scholars, he produces a commanding overview of "the sum of creative activities during this period" (p. x) in all their dynamic complexity.

From the outset, Galinsky sets forth his project in relation to those that have preceded it, especially *The Roman Revolution* (1939), "an Augustan mirror for the political events of the 1920s and 1930s" with Augustus as a ruthless party leader comparable to Mussolini or Hitler who themselves, to varying degrees, took Augustus as their model (3). G. rightly recommends reading this classic historical narrative in conjunction with his own text (ix-x), while at the same time assessing its consequences for literary and art historical interpretation, where dichotomies such as "pro-" versus "anti-Augustan" and *Hellenismus versus Klassizismus* (4-5) have abounded. He will develop these themes in chaps. 5 and 7, but acknowledges here as well the inspiration of the work of Zanker, whose *Power of images in the age of Augustus* seems a constant point of reference. Although I agree with G. that "we are looking at the Augustan age with different eyes in the 1990s than our forebears in the 1930s," I question to what extent this is because

we have witnessed that 'ideology' and 'propaganda' are inadequate foundations for lasting political systems. We live in a complex and changing world that defies conceptual straitjackets and facile bipolarities, both in domestic politics and on the international scene. And we also have come to realize the need for true values ... (5).

Certainly there has been a transformation in the sheer quantity of archaeological information available, since fully half of the now-canonical major monuments that G. will discuss have been excavated, re-assembled, or re-analyzed in the past 30 years. However, I challenge the notion that the latter-day 20th c. has somehow recovered from ideology and propaganda and recognized "the need for true values ...". Postmodern critics may have focused attention on the fundamental importance of dichotomies to modern western thinking,¹ but they are still very much with us, as G.'s own construction indicates.

He concludes his introduction by urging his readers to consider the *res publica* which Augustus restored not as "the Republic" but as the "commonwealth" with its tradition of custom (*mos*) and law (*ius*), the re-establishment of the protection of private property and other aspects of material welfare, as well as routes for participation in the state religion for a wider spectrum of the population. "Instead of a Roman revolution, it is more accurate to speak of an Augustan evolution" (6-9).

In Chapter 1, G. argues persuasively for the fundamental importance of Augustus' possession of *auctoritas*, a discussion which stems from *Res Gestae* 34.3 and Heinze's 1925 essay, but which is particularly vital here for a cultural model in which "there is a strong center of ideas ... and a clear authorial intentionality that, far from being confining, encourages creative response and interpretation" especially in art and literature (12). The flexibility of the term, its basis in mutuality, and even the etymological link between *auctoritas* and Augustus, establish what

theories of the date of the epistle The author concludes that while there are limitations to an imperial critical reading of the epistle some of the epistle's speech acts can be understood as subversive of Roman imperial ideology
