found in one (and only one) place. There are a number of other changes that will be appreciated by many readers. For example, in recognition of the fact that the publication guide is used by disciplines in the behavioural sciences other than psychology (including business and education), there is a deliberate effort to include details and examples that go beyond the scope of psychology. Guidance on levels of headings, always a source of confusion, has been simplified, as has the information on providing citations. One of the most useful additions is checklists for ethical compliance, tables, figures, and manuscript submissions. So what's in it for anyone whose career has spanned one or more previous editions of the publication manual? In a word, plenty-the members of the Publication Manual Revision Task Force have really beought the manual into the 21st century. For anyone who has struggled with the limited guidance provided in the fifth edition on citations for electronic and web-based media (e.g., DOI citations, wikis, podcasts), the new edition will be a welcome relief. However, for my money, the most important changes have to do with the reporting and presentation of statistics. The information has been updated to be consistent with recent reporting requirements, such as the reporting of effect sizes and confidence intervals. Similarly, the list of statistical abbreviations and symbols has been expanded to include statistics now commonly used (e.g., DIF for differential item functioning, HLM for hierarchical linear modelling, and WLS for weighted least squares). Reflecting the important growth in the use of meta-analysis. (e.g., approximately 50% of review articles in the 2008 volume of Psychological Bulletin were meta-analyses), far more information in provided on reporting details in quantitative literature reviews. Indeed, reporting standards for meta-analyses are included in an appendix, and reporting standards such as CONSORT and TREND were used to develop the generic journal article reporting standards that also appear in the appropriation.

All in all, then, this is a valuable and timely updating of the guide to APA style. For those entering the realms of reading, writing, and publishing behavioural science research, it is a clear guide that is organised in a useful and logical manner. For those already well versed in APA style, the modifications should make life (at least publication-related aspects of life) somewhat simpler because of improved organisation and coverage of key style elements such as abbreviations and references.

Initiated from a conference in honour of a pioneer researcher in cognition and aging, Dr. K. Warner Schaie, this book selectively summarises the latest methodological developments, broadly reviews recent empirical findings, and briefly describes the implications and challenges in the application of research findings in the area of adult development and aging. Overall, the book is well written, with a good mix of methodological considerations and empirical studies. It presents cutting-edge work of some wellknown researchers in the field. All the chapters, although written in slightly different tones, involve in-depth discussion of current issues, questions, challenges, findings, and implications. They thus could serve as models for critical academic writing. Given the breadth of the topics and the depth of discussion within each topic. this book is a best fit for the readers who have fundamental knowledge and substantial understanding of the topics in the field of human development and aging research. The target audience would be higher level graduate students or established researchers in the specified areas.

The first part of the book covers some methodological issues in research of human development and aging. Chapter 1 offers a broad review of the history of methodological development and some current debutes, largely derived from Schaie's phenomenal Seattle Longitudinal Study, Chapters 2-4 discuss main issues in using factor analysis methodology, such as factor invariance, multilevel factor analysis, and confirmatory factor analysis, in the study of development and aging. Chapter 5 reviews the issues commonly involved in longitudinal studies (e.g., attrition, dropout, and retest effects) and urges considerations of cohort effects that have been routinely ignored in longitudinal studies in examining the convergence assumption. The convergence assumption postulates a similarity between cross-sectional and longitudinal findings. Overall, this part provides a solid and comprehensive review of contemporary methodological issues in research on agine and cognition. Examples of specific studies or data sets are provided to assist understanding. For example, Chapter 4 offers a concrete example in applying confirmatory factor analysis to a common personality measure, the Temperament and Character Inventory, and Chapter 5 highlights the data from the Long Beach Longitudinal Study in support of the convergence assumption at a structural level. However, most chapters in this part are written in such a way that presumably only those who have substantial statistical knowledge and profound experience in modelling would be able to fully understand the content. Readers in behaviour research may find it helpful to have some basic interpretations for the formulas or models presented. Although this part raises some interesting arguments, such as cohort effects in both cross-sectional and longitudinal studies, it would have been even more informative and useful if the discussion had involved some potentially reasonable solutions, such as how to disentangle cohort, period, mortality, and age effects in different research designs.
