Properties of Solids

- **Crystalline Solids:** Atoms, ions, or molecules are arranged in a regular, repeating three-dimensional pattern. They have sharp melting points and distinct X-ray diffraction patterns.
- **Amorphous Solids:** Atoms, ions, or molecules are arranged in a disordered, non-repeating pattern. They do not have sharp melting points and do not show distinct X-ray diffraction patterns.
- **Intermolecular Forces:** The strength of these forces determines the melting point and other physical properties of a solid.
 - **London Dispersion Forces:** Present in all solids, they are the weakest intermolecular forces.
 - **Dipole-Dipole Interactions:** Present in polar solids, they are stronger than London forces.
 - **Hydrogen Bonding:** Present in solids containing N-H, O-H, or F-H bonds, they are the strongest intermolecular forces.
- **Unit Cells:** The smallest repeating unit of a crystal lattice. Common types include simple cubic, body-centered cubic (BCC), and face-centered cubic (FCC).
- **Packing Efficiency:** The fraction of space occupied by atoms in a unit cell. FCC and HCP have the highest packing efficiency (74%), while BCC has a lower efficiency (68%).

Types of Chemical Calculations

Key to Success on the Exam

- **Stoichiometry:** Calculations involving the relative amounts of reactants and products in a chemical reaction.
- **Thermochemistry:** Calculations involving heat (enthalpy) changes in chemical reactions.
- **Equilibrium:** Calculations involving the concentrations of reactants and products at equilibrium.
- **Acid-Base Chemistry:** Calculations involving pH, pKa, and the concentrations of acids and bases.
- **Solubility:** Calculations involving the concentrations of ions in saturated solutions.
- **Electrochemistry:** Calculations involving cell potentials, Gibbs free energy, and the amount of substance produced or consumed in an electrochemical cell.

Periodic Table & Trends

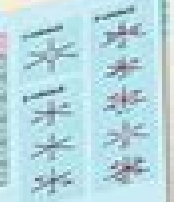
Diagram illustrating the periodic table with trends for atomic radius, ionization energy, and electronegativity.

- **Atomic Radius:** Increases from top-left to bottom-right.
- **Ionization Energy:** Increases from bottom-right to top-left.
- **Electronegativity:** Increases from bottom-right to top-left.

Electronegativity Table

- **Electronegativity increases from left to right and from bottom to top.**
- **Fluorine (F) is the most electronegative element (4.0).**
- **Francium (Fr) is the least electronegative element (0.7).**

- **Linear:** 180° bond angle.

Thermodynamics

First Law of Thermodynamics: Energy cannot be created or destroyed, only transferred or converted from one form to another.

Second Law of Thermodynamics: The total entropy of an isolated system can never decrease over time.

Equilibrium & Solubility

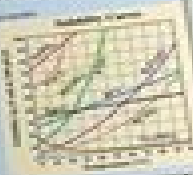
Le Chatelier's Principle: If a system at equilibrium is subjected to a change in concentration, temperature, or pressure, the system will shift to counteract the change.

Electrochemistry

Nernst Equation: Relates the cell potential to the concentrations of the reactants and products.

Gibbs Free Energy: A thermodynamic potential that can be used to determine the spontaneity of a process.



Acids & Bases

Arrhenius Definition: An acid is a substance that increases the concentration of H^+ ions in aqueous solution, and a base is a substance that increases the concentration of OH^- ions.

Brønsted-Lowry Definition: An acid is a proton donor, and a base is a proton acceptor.

Conjugate Acid-Base Pairs: Two species that differ by only one proton.

pH and pKa: Measures of acidity and basicity.

Buffer Solutions: Solutions that resist changes in pH when small amounts of acid or base are added.

Titration Curves: Graphs showing the pH of a solution as a function of the volume of titrant added.

Indicators: Substances that change color at a specific pH range.

Common Ion Effect: The effect of adding a common ion to a solution of a weak acid or base.

Hydrolysis: The reaction of an ion with water to produce an acidic or basic solution.

Complex Ion Formation: The reaction of a metal ion with a ligand to form a complex ion.

Redox Reactions: Chemical reactions in which the oxidation states of the reactants change.

Electrolysis: The process of using an electric current to drive a non-spontaneous chemical reaction.

It would be extremely helpful to find someone who is willing to score your essay your teachers or anyone who is familiar with the test material If you do ask the person to assign each of your U S and Comparative Part I essays a score of 0 to 9 For your Comparative Part II essays use the 0 to 5 scale If you must grade your own essays try to be objective In addition you may want to give your essays three different grades For instance if you feel you did well try giving the essay a score of 5 6 or 7 to represent the various scores you may receive By underestimating what your score may be you are more likely to receive a better score on the actual exam Use the following formulae to determine your raw score for the Free Response section

Scores that Earn College Credit and or Advanced Placement Most colleges grant students who earn a 3 or above college credit and or advanced placement You should check with your school guidance office about specific college requirements

Studying for Your AP Examination It is never too early to start studying The earlier you begin the more time you will have to sharpen your skills Do not procrastinate Cramming is not an effective way to study since it does not allow you the time needed to learn the test material It is very important for you to choose the time and place for studying that works best for you Some students may set aside a certain number of hours every morning to study while others may choose to study at night before going to sleep Other students may study during the day while waiting on a line or even while eating lunch Only you can determine when and where your study time will be most effective But be consistent and use your time wisely Work out a study routine and stick to it When you take the practice exam s try to make your testing conditions as much like the actual test as possible Turn your television and radio off and sit down at a quiet table free from distraction Make sure to time yourself As you complete the practice test s score your test s and thoroughly review the explanations to the questions you answered incorrectly but do not review too much during any one sitting Concentrate on one problem area at a time by reviewing the question and explanation and by studying our review s until you are confident that you completely understand the material Since you will be allowed to write in your test booklet during the actual exam you may want to write in the margins and spaces of this book when practicing However do not make miscellaneous notes on your answer sheet Mark your answers clearly and make sure the answer you have chosen corresponds to the question you are answering Keep track of your scores By doing so you will be able to gauge your progress and discover general weaknesses in particular sections You should carefully study the reviews that cover the topics causing you difficulty as this will build your skills in those areas To get the most out of your studying time we recommend that you follow the Study Schedule which corresponds to the exam you are taking It details how you can best budget your time If you are taking both exams do not try to study for each at the same time Try alternating days by studying for the United States exam one day and the Comparative exam the next

Test Taking Tips Although you may be unfamiliar with tests such as the Advanced Placement exams there are many ways to acquaint yourself with this type of examination and help alleviate your test taking anxieties Listed below are ways to help yourself become accustomed to the AP exam some of which may also be applied to other standardized tests Become comfortable with the format of the AP Examination in Government and Politics that you are taking When you are practicing to take the exam s simulate the conditions under which you will be taking the actual test s You should practice under the same time constraints as well Stay calm and pace yourself After simulating the test only a couple of times you will boost your chances of doing well and you will be able to sit down for the actual test much more confidently Know the directions and format for each section of the exam Familiarizing yourself with the directions and format of the different test sections will not only save you time but will also ensure that you are familiar enough with the AP exam to avoid nervousness and the mistakes caused by being nervous Work on the easier questions first If you find yourself working too long on one question make a mark next to it in your test booklet and continue After you have answered all of the questions that you can go back to the ones you have

skipped Use the process of elimination when you are unsure of an answer If you can eliminate three of the answer choices you have given yourself a fifty fifty chance of getting the item correct since there will only be two choices left from which to make a guess If you cannot eliminate at least three of the answer choices you may choose not to guess as you will be penalized one quarter of a point for every incorrect answer Questions not answered will not be counted Be sure that you are marking your answer in the circle that corresponds to the number of the question in the test booklet Since the multiple choice section is graded by machine marking the wrong answer will throw off your score
