Unit 1: Psychology's History and Approaches

Module 1: *Psychology's History*

- Confucius stressed the power of ideas and of an educated mind
- Socrates and his student Plato concluded that mind is separable from body and continues after the body dies, and that knowledge is innate (*born within us*)
- Aristotle, Plato's student, said knowledge is not preexisting and that it grows from the experiences stored in our memories
- Rene Descartes agreed with Socrates and Plato about the mind being separate from the body and the mind being able to survive after death
- Francis Bacon relied more on common sense and experiments
- John Locke argued that the mind at birth is a tabula rasa on which experience writes
 - Tabula rasa is a blank slate
- **Empiricism:** The view that knowledge originates in experience and that science should rely on observation and experimentation
- Wilhelm Wundt began the first psychological laboratory and was seeking to measure the atoms in the mind
- **Structuralism:** Used introspection to reveal the structure of the human mind
 - Created by Edward Titchener (*Wundt's student*)
- **Functionalism:** Explored how mental and behavioral processes functioned and how they enable the organism to adapt, survive, and flourish
 - Created by William James (*influenced by Charles Darwin*)
- **Experimental Psychology:** The study of behavior and thinking using the experimental method
- Margaret Washburn was the first woman to receive a Ph.D. in psychology
- **Behaviorism:** The view that psychology should be an objective science that studies behavior without interference to mental processes
 - B.F. Skinner is a major behaviorist
- Freudian Psychology is the study of our unconscious and how our emotional responses to childhood experiences affect behavior
 - Led by Sigmund Freud
