Understanding Willing Participants, Volume 2 Nestar Russell, 2018-12-27 Horrified by the Holocaust social psychologist Stanley Milgram wondered if he could recreate the Holocaust in the laboratory setting Unabated for more than half a century his famous results have continued to intrigue scholars Based on unpublished archival data from Milgram's personal collection volume one of this two volume set introduces readers to a behind the scenes account showing how during Milgram's unpublished pilot studies he step by step invented his official experimental procedure how he gradually learnt to transform most ordinary people into willing inflictors of harm The open access volume two then illustrates how certain innovators within the Nazi regime used the very same Milgram like learning techniques that with increasing effectiveness gradually enabled them to also transform most ordinary people into increasingly capable executioners of other men women and children Volume two effectively attempts to capture how step by step these Nazi innovators attempted to transform the Führer's wish of a Jewish free Europe into a frightening reality By the book's end the reader will gain an insight into how the seemingly undoable can become increasingly doable

Impossible Escape Steve Sheinkin, 2023-08-29 From three time National Book Award finalist and Newbery Honor author Steve Sheinkin a true story of two Jewish teenagers racing against time during the Holocaust one in hiding in Hungary and the other in Auschwitz plotting escape It is 1944 A teenager named Rudolf Rudi Vrba has made up his mind After barely surviving nearly two years in the Auschwitz concentration camp in Poland he knows he must escape Even if death is more likely Rudi has learned the terrible secret hidden behind the heavily guarded fences of concentration camps across Nazi occupied Europe the methodical mass killing of Jewish prisoners As trains full of people arrive daily Rudi knows that the murders won't stop until he reveals the truth to the world and that each day that passes means more lives are lost Lives like Rudi's schoolmate Gerta Sidonov Gerta's family fled from Slovakia to Hungary where they live under assumed names to hide their Jewish identity But Hungary is beginning to cave under pressure from German Nazis Her chances of survival become slimmer by the day The clock is ticking As Gerta inches closer to capture Rudi and his friend Alfred Wetzler begin their crucial steps towards an impossible escape This is the true story of one of the most famous whistleblowers in the world and how his death defying escape helped save over 100 000 lives *From the Land of Shadows* Khatharya Um, 2015-10-16 In a century of mass atrocities the Khmer Rouge regime marked Cambodia with one of the most extreme genocidal instances in human history What emerged in the aftermath of the regime's collapse in 1979 was a nation fractured by death and dispersal It is estimated that nearly one fourth of the country's population perished from hard labor disease starvation and executions Another half million Cambodians fled their ancestral homeland with over one hundred thousand finding refuge in America From the Land of Shadows surveys the Cambodian diaspora and the struggle to understand and make meaning of this historical trauma Drawing on more than 250 interviews with survivors across the United States as well as in France and Cambodia Khatharya Um places these accounts in conversation with

studies of comparative revolutions totalitarianism transnationalism and memory works to illuminate the pathology of power as well as the impact of auto genocide on individual and collective healing Exploring the interstices of home and exile forgetting and remembering From the Land of Shadows follows the ways in which Cambodian individuals and communities seek to rebuild connections frayed by time distance and politics in the face of this injurious history

Gallo, 2023-02-15 On October 16 1943 the Jews of Rome were targeted for arrest and deportation The Nazis the Vatican and the Jews of Rome examines why and more importantly how it could have been avoided featuring new evidence and insight into the Vatican's involvement At the time Rome was within reach of the Allies but the overwhelming force of the Wehrmacht Gestapo and SS in Rome precluded direct confrontation Moral condemnations would not have worked nor would direct confrontation by the Italians Jewish leadership or even the Vatican Gallo underscores the necessity of determining what courses of actions most likely would have spared Italian Jews from the gas chambers Examining the historical context and avoiding normative or counterfactual assertions this book draws upon archival sources ranging from diaries to intelligence intercepts in English Italian and German With antisemitism on the rise today and the last remaining witnesses passing away it is essential to understand what happened in 1943 The Nazis the Vatican and the Jews of Rome grapples with this particular awful episode within the larger horrifying story of the Holocaust Despite the inadequacy of memory we must continue to attempt to make sense of the inexplicable

Memory and Totalitarianism Luisa Passerini, Understanding Europe's past became an urgent matter with the events of August 1991 in Moscow in the former Soviet Union The invasion of Moscow's streets by Russian people rejecting an attempted coup d'etat was the culmination of a process that had been initiated years before and raised crucial questions To what extent can these events be considered the end of an era stretching from World War I to the 1980s when Europe experienced many forms of dictatorship To what extent can the various forms of dictatorship Europe experienced in the twentieth century be grouped together Can any sort of affinity be established between them The new introduction to the paperback edition of this volume in the *Memory and Narrative* series Leydesdorff and Crownshaw underline the fundamental importance of the struggle for memory and its meaning *Memory and Totalitarianism* explores the remembered experiences of

individuals living under different totalitarian regimes and examines the construction of memory in the aftermath of those regimes collapse It attempts to situate the findings of oral history in the context of contemporary memory It wrestles with the most painful memories that Europeans have of this century at the end of the Cold War These memories compare with oral history s research into such experiences as racist attitudes against blacks in the South or the cultural and psychological effects of apartheid in South Africa or the Aborigines claim to their own history and to a new idea of history in Australia Totalitarianisms are products of the twentieth century that go far beyond earlier manifestations of absolutism and autocracy in their effort to completely control political social and intellectual life They were made possible by modern industrialism and technology Therefore the theme of the book expands to include many other experiences that relate to totalitarian mentalities Luisa Passerini is professor of cultural history at the University of Torino and external professor at the European University Institute Florence Her present trends of research are European identity the historical relationships between the discourse on Europe and the discourse on love gender and generation as historical categories memory and subjectivity Among her recent publications are *Europe in Love* *Love in Europe* *Imagination and Politics Between the Wars* *Il mito d Europa* *Radici antiche per nuovi simboli* Selma Leydesdorff is professor of oral history at the University of Amsterdam Her publications include *We Lived with Dignity* and with Kim Lacy Rogers *Trauma Life Stories of Survivors* Richard Crownshaw is a lecturer in the Department of English at Manchester Metropolitan University UK where his teaching includes 19th and 20th century American literature and representations of the Holocaust He is also an Associate Fellow of the Institute of Germanic and Romance Studies University of London

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
