The results suggest fruitful applications of theory to explore how knowledge is generated in highly structured high risk organizational environments such as hospitals nuclear plants battlefields and crisis and disaster locations Katerinakis explains the emergent knowledge elements in communication command with messages spoken heard understood applied from multiple stakeholders.
