pursuit of large money prizes in competitions held in big city arenas Walking was also a favorite amateur sport newspapers often noted a pedestrian mania or walking fever that only began to give way in the mid 1880s to fast rising crazes for baseball bicycling and roller skating As competitive walking faded however another kind of walking that had also begun in the late 1860s came to full flower Between 1890 and 1930 hundreds of men women even children and entire families were on the nation's roads and railroad tracks trekking between widely separated points frequently New York and San Francisco and sometimes moving in unusual ways such as on roller skates or by walking barefooted backwards on stilts or while rolling a hoop To finance their attention seeking journeys many sold souvenir postcards Although they claimed various reasons for making these treks for most the treks clearly were a means of personal expression.
