- Allows emotional responses to “happen how they happen” rather than try to deny them or make them different from what they are.
- Think of a child you know
 - From an abusive background
 - With a family member in prison
 - With an intellectual disability
- ALL children experience distressing thoughts
- The older and the more cognitively developed the child gets the more they worry about fitting in
- When was the first time you noticed feeling that you didn't fit in?
- When was the last time?
- This teaches them the skill that they can feel an emotion without trying to change the emotion **AND** still do what's important to them.
