Quick Start Guide

This guide is designed to help programs improve screening implementation using the *Ages & Stages Questionnaire, Third Edition (ASQ-3)*. A Parent-Completed Child Monitoring System. You may not always have ready access to your ASQ-3 Parent's Guide, and the ASQ-3 Quick Start Guide is a quick reference when administering and scoring ASQ-3 and working with families.

ABOUT ASQ-3

ASQ-3 is a comprehensive screening and monitoring system that helps accurately identify infants or young children in need of further evaluation to determine whether they are eligible for early intervention or early childhood special education services. ASQ-3 is composed of 21 questionnaires designed to be completed by parents or other primary caregivers for children between 1 month and 6 1/2 years of age.

ORGANIZATION OF THE QUESTIONNAIRES

ASQ-3 questionnaire intervals are 1, 6, 9, 12, 15, 18, 24, 30, 36, 42, 48, 54, and 60 months of age. The 1 and 6 month questionnaires are new to the third edition. Each questionnaire has a cover sheet to collect family information and a return provided on (2) PDM, (3) 40 question, and an ASQ-3 Information Summary for recording, scoring, and follow-up.

SELECTING THE CORRECT QUESTIONNAIRE

Select the questionnaire interval that corresponds to the child's age at the time the screening will be performed, except if the child was born 3 or more weeks prematurely and is less than 36 months old. Administration windows for the questionnaire intervals are clearly marked at the top of each family information sheet and initial questionnaire page. Refer to page viii in the ASQ-3 Parent's Guide for a complete listing of administration windows.

Calculating the Child's Chronological Age The child's exact age is calculated by subtracting the date of birth from the expected date of screening administration. See the examples below and on the next page.
