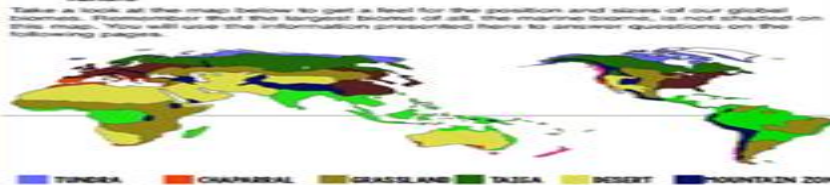

BIOMES

Earth is an amazing planet. It has many different environments that make perfect homes for millions of species. The largest major habitats that exist worldwide are known as **biomes**. Most likely, you're familiar with many of these: desert, rainforest, grassland, etc. Each biome is unique and has its own set of characteristics that make it different from the others. One of the most important factors in determining a biome is the amount of water and the amount of sunlight it receives.

How many biomes are there? Do all water environments constitute a single aquatic biome? Are all fire-filled ecosystems considered a forest biome? The number of biomes you could find simply depends on how specific you'd like to be. Let's take a look at some of the largest biomes, and the abiotic and biotic factors that define them.

For fish, birds, frogs, whales, and other aquatic species. **Aquatic Biomes** Since water covers over 70% of the Earth, the largest biomes are the aquatic biomes. Marine biomes include coral reefs and estuaries, but the two major ones are the marine and freshwater biomes. The **marine** biome, made up of the world's oceans, is so big it's usually divided into **deep-sea** and **shallow-sea** biomes. It's so big, the deep-sea is actually 4 times larger than all of Earth's other biomes combined. The **shallow-sea** biome is the most diverse of all aquatic biomes, creating ocean currents which play a major role in creating ecosystems. Smaller **freshwater** biomes consist of lakes, ponds, and rivers. These are often home to many different species of fish and other aquatic life. Freshwater biomes are especially important to us humans as they provide the water that we use to drink. All aquatic biomes provide homes for diverse plant and animal life, and other biomes provide oxygen through photosynthesis.

Grassland Grassland biomes live up to their name! They're made up of open and very few trees. The two major grassland biomes are the **savanna** and **temperate grassland**. The **savanna** is a type of grassland that covers half of Africa and large parts of Australia. These areas have a 6-8 month wet season in the summer and a 4-6 month dry season in the winter. Elephants, giraffes, and other animals live in the savanna. The **temperate grasslands**, on the other hand, make up the plains of middle America.
