Brief Den Vater Franz Kafka:

Letter to the Father/Brief an den Vater Franz Kafka, 2015-11-03 A son's poignant letter to his father from the author of *The Metamorphosis* and *The Trial* and one of the most important writers of the twentieth century. One of the great confessions of literature. *The New York Times Book Review* Franz Kafka wrote this letter to his father Hermann Kafka in November 1919. Max Brod, Kafka's literary executor, relates that Kafka actually gave the letter to his mother to hand to his father, hoping it might renew a relationship that had lost itself in tension and frustration on both sides. But Kafka's probing of the deep flaw in their relationship spared neither his father nor himself. He could not help seeing the failure of communication between father and son as another moment in the larger existential predicament depicted in so much of his work. Probably realizing the futility of her son's gesture, Julie Kafka did not deliver the letter but instead returned it to its author.

Brief an den Vater Franz Kafka, 1987 **Brief an den Vater (Vollständige Ausgabe)** Franz Kafka, 2017-11 Der Brief an den Vater ist ein 1919 verfasster, niemals abgeschickter Brief Franz Kafkas an seinen Vater. Er wurde postum 1952 in der *Neuen Rundschau* veröffentlicht und ist ein bevorzugter Text für psychoanalytische und biographische Studien über Kafka. Nachdem Franz Kafka im Januar 1919 bei einem Kuraufenthalt in Scheersee bei Böhmen Julie Wohryzek kennengelernt hatte und sich einige Monate später mit ihr verlobte, reagierte sein Vater ungehalten auf seine neuen und unstandesgemäßen Heiratspläne. Es wird angenommen, dass dies der Auslöser für die Verfassung des Briefes zwischen dem 10. und 13. November 1919 war. Der ausladende Brief besteht im Original aus 103 handschriftlichen Seiten, auf denen Kafka versucht, seinen Vaterkonflikt schreibend zu bewältigen. Viele seiner Lebensschwierigkeiten schreibt er der totalen Wesensverschiedenheit zwischen sich und dem Vater zu. In erster Linie wird im Brief die Wesensunverträglichkeit herausgearbeitet. Hermann, der kraftvolle, impulsiv-jähzornige Vater, Sohn eines Fleischhauers ohne Bildung, der sich emporgearbeitet hat. Der Sohn Franz verweicht und unselbstständig durch des Vaters Wohlstand völlig vernachlässigt, unzugänglich und eingesponnen in seine geistige Welt. Franz Kafka (1883-1924) war ein deutschsprachiger Schriftsteller. Sein Hauptwerk bilden neben drei Romanfragmenten *Der Prozess*, *Das Schloss* und *Der Verschollene* zahlreiche Erzählungen.

Kafka's Zoopoetics Naama Harel, 2020-05-04 Nonhuman figures are ubiquitous in the work of Franz Kafka from his early stories down to his very last one Despite their prominence throughout his oeuvre Kafka's animal representations have been considered first and foremost as mere allegories of intrahuman matters In recent years the allegorization of Kafka's animals has been poetically dismissed by Kafka's commentators and politically rejected by posthumanist scholars Such critique however has yet to inspire either an overarching or an interdiscursive account This book aims to fill this lacuna Positioning animal stories as a distinct and significant corpus within Kafka's entire poetics and closely examining them in dialogue with both literary and posthumanist analysis Kafka's Zoopoetics critically revisits animality interspecies relations and the very human animal contradistinction in the writings of Franz Kafka Kafka's animals typically stand at the threshold between humanity and animality fusing together human and nonhuman features Among his liminal creatures we find a human transformed into vermin in *The Metamorphosis* an ape turned into a human being in *A Report to an Academy* talking jackals in *Jackals and Arabs* a philosophical dog in *Researches of a Dog* a contemplative mole like creature in *The Burrow* and indiscernible beings in *Josefine the Singer or the Mouse People* Depicting species boundaries as mutable and obscure Kafka creates a fluid human animal space which can be described as humanimal The constitution of a humanimal space radically undermines the stark barrier between human and other animals dictated by the anthropocentric paradigm Through denying animalistic elements in humans and disavowing the agency of nonhuman animals excluding them from social life and neutralizing compassion for them this barrier has been designed to regularize both humanity and animality The contextualization of Kafka's animals within posthumanist theory engenders a post anthropocentric arena which is simultaneously both imagined and very real
