Godin, 1999 Teleost bony fishes are found in all types of aquatic environment and are extremely diverse behaviorally Their evolutionary success is partly due to their striking behavioral plasticity as such they are also extremely useful organisms for the study of mechanistic and functional models of behavior Considerable progress has been made over the past decade in understanding how behavior ecology and genetics interact to determine individual survival and reproductive success in fishes and thus the evolution of their behavior Behavioural Ecology of Teleost Fishes reviews the latest advances in behavioral adaptations for survival and reproduction in fishes and proposes new directions and approaches for future research The book focuses on habitat selection and space use foraging predator avoidance and evasion and reproduction It also considers how the behaviour of individuals affects ecological processes at population and community levels The book benefits students teachers and researchers interested in the behavior and ecology of fishes as well as those with a general interest in behavioral ecology It is also a valuable reference source for biologists aquaculturists and conservationists

Kapoor, 2008-01-09 Fishes are by far the most species rich vertebrate taxon and it is also the vertebrate group with the most strikingly diverse repertoire of behaviours and behavioural adaptations As such they provide us with many opportunities to explore the fascinating complexities of animal behaviour Central questions addressed in this book include How do se **Behavioral Ecology of Coral Reef Fishes at Spawning Aggregation Sites** Gorka Sancho, 1998 This thesis is an extensive investigation of the behavioral and ecological relationships between spawning reef fishes their predators and various environmental parameters at spawning aggregation sites Underwater observations of spawning activities by eleven reef fish species and the hunting behaviors of both piscivorous and planktivorous predators were made at Johnston Atoll Central Pacific The spawning of reef fishes was typically correlated with local changes in current direction and predatory risks in daytime spawning species showing responses designed to reduce the mortality of propagules and adults Dusk spawning species generally did not respond to changes in flow direction or predator abundance Piscivores were most active at spawning sites during the daytime hours when spawning prey fish were most abundant but showed low activity at dusk the period of highest prey diversity Alternate hunting behaviors midwater or ambush attacks were used by piscivores when feeding on spawning fishes and resulted in different capture success rates The difference in heights of spawning ascents by two trunkfish species was interpreted to be the result of intraspecific competition among males and could not be explained by interspecific differences in susceptibility to predation estimated as a function of the specific toxicity of both species Stinet **Handbook of Fish Biology and Fisheries** Paul J.
