Introduction

- Population ecology is the study of populations (especially population abundance) and how they change over time.
- Crucial to this study are the various interactions between a population and its resources. A population can decline because it lacks resources or it can decline because it is prey to another species that is increasing in numbers.
- Populations are limited by their resources in its capacity to grow; the maximum population abundance (for a given species) an environment can sustain is called the carrying capacity.
