Mochalov, 2016-12-31 The first English language monograph that describes seasonal and permanent Late Bronze Age settlements in the Russian steppes this is the final report of the Samara Valley Project a US Russian archaeological investigation conducted between 1995 and 2002 It explores the changing organization and subsistence resources of pastoral steppe economies from the Eneolithic 4500 BC through the Late Bronze Age 1900 1200 BC across a steppe and river valley landscape in the middle Volga region with particular attention to the role of agriculture during the unusual episode of sedentary settled pastoralism that spread across the Eurasian steppes with the Srubnaya and Andronovo cultures 1900 1200 BC Three astonishing discoveries were made by the SVP archaeologists agriculture played no role in the LBA diet across the region a surprise given the settled residential pattern a unique winter ritual was practiced at Krasnosamarskoe involving dog and wolf sacrifices possibly related to male initiation ceremonies and overlapping spheres of obligation cooperation and affiliation operated at different scales to integrate groups defined by politics economics and ritual behaviors European Archaeology as Anthropology Pam J. Crabtree, Peter Bogucki, 2017-03-21 Since the days of V Gordon Childe the study of the emergence of complex societies has been a central question in anthropological archaeology However archaeologists working in the Americanist tradition have drawn most of their models for the emergence of social complexity from research in the Middle East and Latin America Bernard Wailes was a strong advocate for the importance of later prehistoric and early medieval Europe as an alternative model of sociopolitical evolution and trained generations of American archaeologists now active in European research from the Neolithic to the Middle Ages Two centuries of excavation and research in Europe have produced one of the richest bodies of archaeological data anywhere in the world The abundant data show that technological innovations such as metallurgy appeared very early but urbanism and state formation are comparatively late developments Key transformative process such as the spread of agriculture did not happen uniformly but rather at different rates in different regions The essays in this volume celebrate the legacy of Bernard Wailes by highlighting the contribution of the European archaeological record to our understanding of the emergence of social complexity They provide case studies in how ancient Europe can inform anthropological archaeology Not only do they illuminate key research topics they also invite archaeologists working in other parts of the world to consider comparisons to ancient Europe as they construct models for cultural development for their regions Although there is a substantial corpus of literature on European prehistoric and medieval archaeology we do not know of a comparable volume that explicitly focuses on the contribution that the study of ancient Europe can make to anthropological archaeology *The Wari Enclave of Espiritu Pampa* Brian S Bauer, Javier Fonseca Santa Cruz, 2020-12-31 The Wari State was the first expansionistic power to develop in the Andean highlands Emerging in the area of modern Ayacucho Peru around AD 650 the Wari expanded to control much of the central

Andes by the time of their collapse at AD 1000 This book describes the discovery and excavation 2010 2012 of a major new Wari site Espiritu Pampa located in the subtropical region of Vilcabamba Department of Cuzco While it was long believed that the Wari established trade networks between their highland capital and the Amazonian lowlands the identification of a large Wari site in the Vilcabamba region came as a surprise to most Wari specialists This book covers the first three years of excavations at the Wari site of Espiritu Pampa It describes the identification of a central plaza surrounded by a series of D shaped structures that are believed to be the loci of special activities for the Wari It also describes the contents of more than 30 burials many of which contained finely crafted silver gold bronze and ceramic objects

Tracing the Indo-Europeans

Birgit Anette Olsen, Thomas Olander, Kristian Kristiansen, 2019-08-23 Recent developments in aDNA have reshaped our understanding of later European prehistory and at the same time also opened up for more fruitful collaborations between archaeologists and historical linguists Two revolutionary genetic studies published independently in Nature 2015 showed that prehistoric Europe underwent two successive waves of migration one from Anatolia consistent with the introduction of agriculture and a later influx from the Pontic Caspian steppes which without any reasonable doubt pinpoints the archaeological Yamnaya complex as the cradle of Core Indo European languages Now for the first time when the preliminaries are clear it is possible for the fields of genetics archaeology and historical linguistics to cooperate in a constructive fashion to refine our knowledge of the Indo European homeland migrations society and language For the historical comparative linguists this opens up a wealth of exciting perspectives and new working fields in the intersections between linguistics and neighbouring disciplines for the archaeologists and geneticists on the other hand the linguistic contributions help to endow the material findings with a voice from the past The present selection of papers illustrates the importance of an open interdisciplinary discussion which will gradually help us in our quest of Tracing the Indo Europeans

appears to have been a period of local political turmoil The decline of Paso de la Amada corresponded with a rupture in local traditions of material culture and local adoption of the Early Olmec style Stylistically the material culture of Paso de la Amada corresponds predominantly to the pre Olmec Mokaya tradition Excavations at the site have revealed significant earthen constructions from as early as 1700 BC Those include the earliest known Mesoamerican ball court and traces of a series of high status residences This monograph reports on large scale excavations in Mounds 1 12 and 32 as well as soundings in other locations The volume covers all aspects of excavations and artifacts and includes three lengthy interpretive chapters dealing with the main research questions which concern subsistence social inequality and the organizational history of the site
