interpretations of the earthworks as either military defences or the community binding symbols Along with Excavation Experiment and Heritage Interpretation Castell Henllys Hillfort Then and Now these books will be required reading by those studying the late prehistoric archaeology of Britain and Europe at advanced undergraduate and postgraduate level and by those in North America studying complex societies monumentality and ways of writing archaeology
