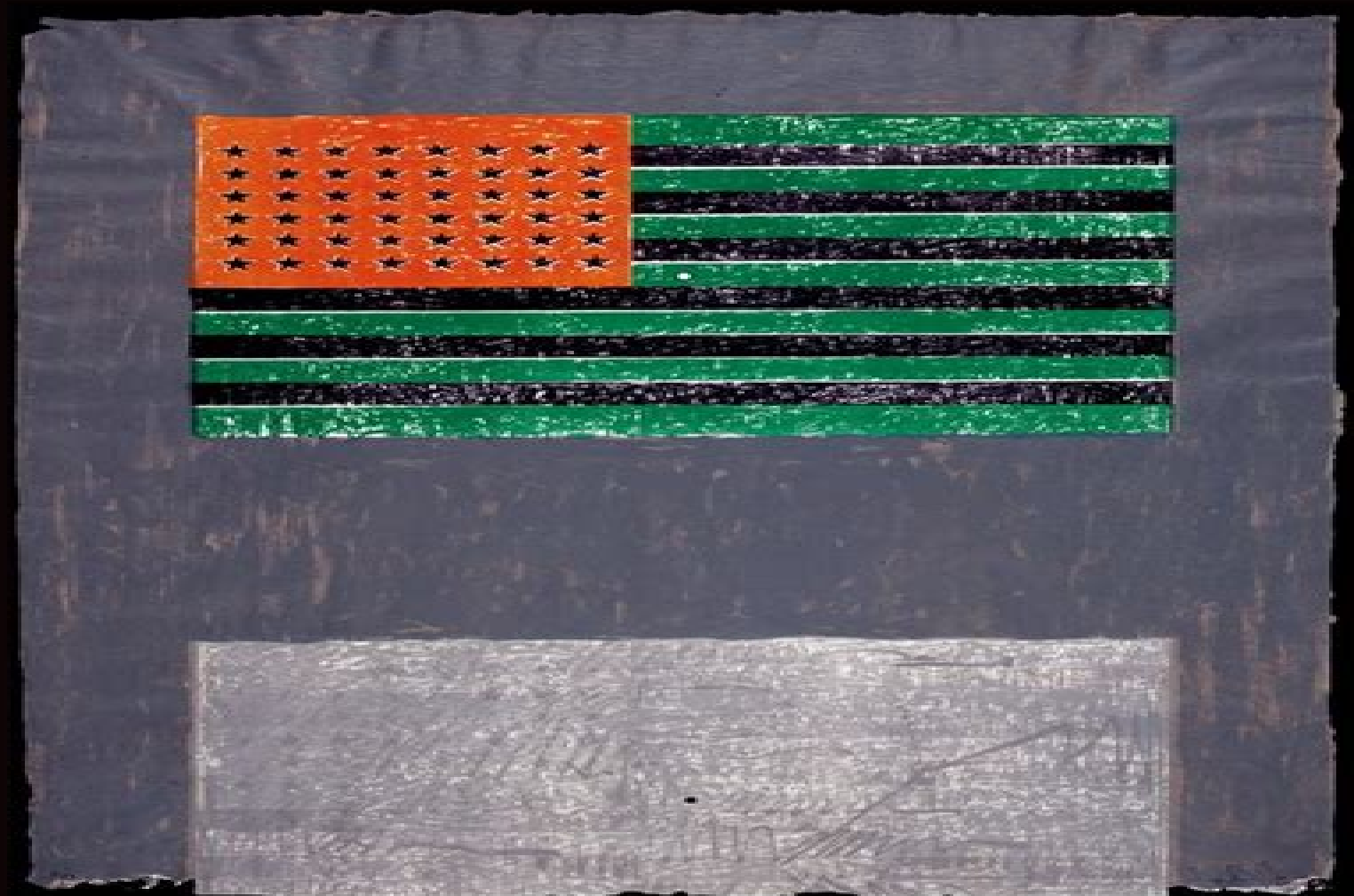

Sears, 2014-08-11 The civil rights movement and immigration reform transformed American politics in the mid 1960s Demographic diversity and identity politics raised the challenge of e pluribus unum anew and multiculturalism emerged as a new ideological response to this dilemma This book uses national public opinion data and public opinion data from Los Angeles to compare ethnic differences in patriotism and ethnic identity and ethnic differences in support for multicultural norms and group conscious policies The authors find evidence of strong patriotism among all groups and the classic pattern of assimilation among the new wave of immigrants They argue that there is a consensus in rejecting harder forms of multiculturalism that insist on group rights but also a widespread acceptance of softer forms that are tolerant of cultural differences and do not challenge norms such as by insisting on the primacy of English

Citizenship after Yugoslavia Jo Shaw, Igor Štiks, 2013-10-31 This book is the first comprehensive examination of the citizenship regimes of the new states that emerged out of the break up of Yugoslavia It covers both the states that emerged out of the initial disintegration across 1991 and 1992 Slovenia Croatia Bosnia Herzegovina the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and Macedonia as well as those that have been formed recently through subsequent partitions Serbia Montenegro and Kosovo While citizenship has often been used as a tool of ethnic engineering to reinforce the position of the titular majority in many states in other cases citizenship laws and practices have been liberalised as part of a wider political settlement intended to include minority communities more effectively in the political process Meanwhile frequent re definitions of these increasingly overlapping regimes still provoke conflicts among post Yugoslav states This volume shows how important it is for the field of citizenship studies to take into account the main changes in and varieties of citizenship regimes in the post Yugoslav states as a particular case of new state citizenship At the same time it seeks to show scholars of post Yugoslavia and the wider Balkans that the Yugoslav crisis disintegration and wars as well as the current functioning of

It has served as a base for modernisation, secularisation and democratisation and also for the formation of totalitarian regimes. Today the nation state faces challenges from multiple directions. National minorities demand self-determination while religious forces challenge secular governments and global migration movements undermine the cultural uniformity once considered essential for the formation and preservation of nation states. This is the third of a three-volume set detailed below which addresses key challenges facing the contemporary nation state from a global perspective but with special emphasis on the Middle East and Israel. Publication reflects research conducted under the auspices of The Israel Democracy Institute's Nation State Project which analyses Israel's complex reality in which a Jewish majority contends with an Arab minority, ultra-Orthodox religious forces reject the authority of the nation state and an immigrant society exhibits substantial cultural and ethnic variance. Volume III explores the cultural, social and political effects of immigration on the contemporary nation state, its character, cohesion and possible future as well as on contemporary liberal democracy. Contributions deal with such issues as different liberal approaches to the issue of immigration and immigrant integration, nation-building narratives and their implications for immigrants and minorities, citizenship tests and integration policy in the United States and in Europe as well as Israel's Law of Return and the debate about it and other aspects of immigration policy.

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
