In addition to exploring the historical and ecclesiastical context within which he worked, this book brings de Lubac into critical engagement with the more recent theological movements of postliberalism and radical orthodoxy.

Nature, Grace, and Secular Culture Christian C. Iradi, 2024-09-13. The relationship between nature and grace is a key debate in Fundamental theology. The understanding of how nature and grace relate to each other is also a critically important part in comprehending the underpinnings of Western secular culture and therefore how best to evangelise it. This book compares John Milbank and Joseph Ratzinger, two relatively recent theologians who have both drawn from the insights of Henri de Lubac and have attempted to address the challenge that secular culture presents to the mission of the church. In demonstrating and comparing how each author's approach to the nature-grace couplet consequently determines their respective approach to secular culture, it is hoped that responses to the challenge of secular culture might be more comprehensively considered.

An Introduction to Vatican II as an Ongoing Theological Event Matthew Levering, 2017. Contemporary scholars often refer to the event of Vatican II, but what kind of an event was it? In this first book of the new CUA Press series *Sacra Doctrina*, Matthew Levering leads his readers to see the Council as a theological event: a period of confirming and continuing God's self-revelation in Christ into a new historical era for the Church. This is an introduction to Vatican II with a detailed summary of each of its four central documents: the dogmatic constitutions followed by explanations of how to interpret them. In contrast to other introductions which pay little attention to the theological soil in which the documents of Vatican II germinated, Levering offers a reading of each conciliar Constitution in light of a key theological author from the era: René Latourelle SJ for *Dei Verbum*, persons and propositions; Louis Bouyer CO for *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, active participation; Yves Congar OP for *Lumen Gentium*, true and false reform; and Henri de Lubac SJ for *Gaudium et Spes*, nature and grace. This theological event is ongoing. Levering demonstrates by tracing in each chapter the theological debates that have stretched from the close of the council till the present and the difficulties the Church continues to encounter in encouraging an ever deeper participation in Jesus Christ on the part of all believers. In this light, the book's final chapter compares the historicist Massimo Faggioli and Christological Robert Imbelli's interpretations of Vatican II, arguing that historicism can undermine the Council's fundamental desire for a reform and renewal rooted in Christ. The conclusion addresses the concerns about secularization and loss of faith raised after the Council by Henri de Lubac, Joseph Ratzinger, and Yves Congar, arguing that contemporary Vatican II scholarship needs to take these concerns more seriously.

God or the Divine? Bernhard Nitsche, Marcus Schmücker, 2023-03-20. Is there a language of transcendence which does not fall under the well-worn categories of monism, theism, pantheism, biblical or pagan monotheism, personal or tripersonal God, or an impersonal absolute conceived as immanent and/or transcendent? politics for the sake of answering a second intrinsically related but really distinct question what is God doing in human action Ambiguity finds that the recent controversy almost always finds participants attempting to deduce an answer to the second modern problem from the medieval metaphysical Thomist solution to the first By contrast The Ambiguity of Being argues at length the modern problem cannot be reduced to nor an answer deduced from its medieval metaphysical partner because the modern problem of the supernatural what is God doing in human action is a hermeneutical problem that calls out for a hermeneutical answer The Ambiguity of Being sketches a heuristic for what a fully adequate answer to this question would require suggesting a radical re conception of modern theology s scope
