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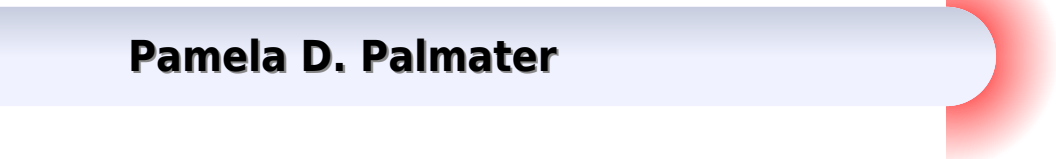

Palmater, 2011-05-13 The current Status criteria of the Indian Act contains descent based rules akin to blood quantum that are particularly discriminatory against women and their descendants which author Pamela Palmater argues will lead to the extinguishment of First Nations as legal and constitutional entities Beginning with an historic overview of legislative enactments defining Indian status and their impact on First Nations the author examines contemporary court rulings dealing with Indigenous identity Aboriginal rights and the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms Palmater also examines band membership codes to determine if their reliance on status criteria perpetuates discrimination She offers changes for determining Indigenous identity and citizenship and argues that First Nations must determine citizenship themselves

Free to Be Mohawk Louellyn White, 2015-11-12 Akwesasne territory straddles the U S Canada border in upstate New York Ontario and Quebec In 1979 in the midst of a major conflict regarding self governance traditional Mohawks there asserted their sovereign rights to self education Concern over the loss of language and culture and clashes with the public school system over who had the right to educate their children sparked the birth of the Akwesasne Freedom School AFS and its grassroots community based approach In *Free to Be Mohawk* Louellyn White traces the history of the AFS a tribally controlled school operated without direct federal state or provincial funding and explores factors contributing to its longevity and its impact on alumni students teachers parents and staff Through interviews participant observations and archival research White presents an in depth picture of the Akwesasne Freedom School as a model of Indigenous holistic education that incorporates traditional teachings experiential methods and language immersion Alumni parents and teachers describe how the school has fostered a strong sense of what it is to be fully Mohawk White explores the complex relationship between language and identity and shows how AFS participants transcend historical colonization by negotiating their sense of self According to Mohawk elder Sakokwenionkwaw Tom Porter The prophecies say that the time will come when the grandchildren will speak to the whole world The reason for the Akwesasne Freedom School is so the grandchildren will have something significant to say In a world where forced assimilation and colonial education have resulted in the loss or endangerment of hundreds of Indigenous languages the Akwesasne Freedom School provides a cultural and linguistic sanctuary White s timely study reminds readers including the Canadian and U S governments of the critical importance of an Indigenous nation s authority over the education of its children

News Framing of Indigenous Politics in Canada Brian Budd, 2024-07-31 This book explores the news media s coverage of Indigenous settler reconciliation following the conclusion of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada TRC Using a comparative case study research design the book examines news coverage of three significant Indigenous rights issues and events during the post TRC era The findings presented demonstrate that in the post TRC era the Canadian news media continue to produce systemic patterns in coverage which reject marginalize and erase the territorial rights and claims of Indigenous Peoples The author concludes that rather than helping to move the relationship between Indigenous Peoples and settlers forward along a path of reconciliation power sharing and the resurgence of land based self determination the news media are continuing to construct discourses and representations that work against the political objectives of Indigenous Peoples and reinforce settler colonial power relationships in Canada
