God in the Corridors of Power Christian Conservatives the Media and Politics in America is a comprehensive study of Christian conservative power in America's political culture how it was achieved how it is maintained and where it is going It came about in part because of an enduring influence in the school room the seminary and in the pulpit and in part because conservatives are so skilled at using commercial and non commercial media including religious media to disseminate their views to broader audiences Though their power has waxed and waned they continue to be a potent force in public policy today The authors argue that the astonishing electoral successes of Christian conservatives at all levels of national state and local government was made possible by linking political social media and religious interests with an emerging consensus about what constitutes a conservative mindset in American politics Christian conservatives unquestionably have been the most significant component in a coalition of religious conservatives traditionalist conservatives and neoconservatives that has driven the Republican Party now for almost two generations This multifaceted understanding of Christian conservative activists in religion and politics traces the impact Christian conservatives have had on American Christianity as a whole while also examining the limitations imposed on the Christian conservative agenda by American civil religion the Constitution and case law The authors explore women's reproductive rights in the debate over contraception and abortion and gay civil rights in the debate over gay marriage and family rights The debate over intelligent design and evolution is examined in the context of the campaign to transform public school education The run up to the wars in Afghanistan and Iraq is scrutinized against the background of the declared war on terrorism While the conservative religious and secular coalition within the Republican Party began to fragment even before the end of George W Bush's first term in office it remained a powerful force in the 2004 and 2008 elections The book concludes with some thoughts about the impact of Christian conservatives in politics media and religion in the future

techniques She examines the complexities of his representation of identity the subjectivity in his male homosexual odyssey and identity quest novels and his experimentation with genre She offers a concise yet intricate analysis of the major organizing paradigms and themes genres modes styles and handling of the gay Chicano s oeuvre The book s guiding analysis pays particular attention to the ways in which Rechy s works function as cultural critique challenging mainstream values in a deep structure manner

Art and Homosexuality Christopher Reed,2011-05-26 This bold globe spanning survey is the first book to thoroughly explore the radical long standing interdependence between art and homosexuality It draws examples from the full range of the Western tradition including classical Renaissance and contemporary art with special focus on the modern era It was in the modern period when arguments about homosexuality and the avant garde were especially public that our current conception of the artist and the homosexual began to take shape and almost as quickly to overlap Not a chronology of gay or lesbian artists the book is a fascinating and sophisticated account of the ways two conspicuous identities have fundamentally informed one another Art and Homosexuality discusses many of modernism s canonical figures painters like Courbet Picasso and Pollock writers like Whitman and Stein and issues such as the rise of abstraction the avant garde s relationship to its patrons and the political exploitation of art It shows that many of the core ideas that define modernism are nearly indecipherable without an understanding of the paired identities of artist and homosexual Illustrated with over 175 b w and color images that range from high to popular culture and from Ancient Greece to contemporary America Art and Homosexuality punctures the platitudes surrounding discussions of both aesthetics and sexual identity and takes our understanding of each in stimulating new directions

Lavender and Red Emily K. Hobson,2016-11-01 LGBT activism is often imagined as a self contained struggle inspired by but set apart from other social movements Lavender and Red recounts a far different story a history of queer radicals who understood their sexual liberation as intertwined with solidarity against imperialism war and racism This politics was born in the late 1960s but survived well past Stonewall propelling a gay and lesbian left that flourished through the end of the Cold War The gay and lesbian left found its center in the San Francisco Bay Area a place where sexual self determination and revolutionary internationalism converged Across the 1970s its activists embraced socialist and women of color feminism and crafted queer opposition to militarism and the New Right In the Reagan years they challenged U S intervention in Central America collaborated with their peers in Nicaragua and mentored the first direct action against AIDS Bringing together archival research oral histories and vibrant images Emily K Hobson rediscovers the radical queer past for a generation of activists today
