- The Anglo-Saxon period of history was also regarded as The Dark Ages, an age marked by intellectual and cultural darkness because of the cold and invasion in the English Isles.
- The Dark Ages had lasted from between 5th Century AD to 10th Century AD. This period of literature and culture began when the monks and missionaries in Rome invaded the English Isles in 430 AD and ended in 1066 AD when William of Normandy won the Battle of Hastings.
- Before the Norman conquest expanded their reach in the English Islands, the central religious system in place for several years during this period was called Paganism. The Celts and Anglo-Saxons that lived in the land before the Norman invasion were the first people to practice paganism.
- The religious practices of paganism before the 5th Century were not well-known, but what is known is that the Celts were polytheistic, and that the Normans brought writing and literature with them alongside Christianity.
- An aspect that existed before Christian influence is known as culture, and it is best known in the Hengid Code. The Hengid Code has different attributes to it, such as:
 - The belief in avenging a murderer's death by slaying them again and an obligation
