The Intelligible World Wilbur Marshall Urban, 2014-06-03 First published in 2002 This is Volume XIV of seventeen in the Library of Philosophy series on Metaphysics Written in 1929 this book is on metaphysics and value in the intelligible world which states that there are only two kinds of philosophies those that find the world ultimately meaningful and intelligible and those that do not The present book claims to belong to the first of these and as such to be apart however modest of the Great Tradition in philosophy *Nietzsche, Heidegger, and Daoist Thought* Katrin Froese, 2012-02-01 In this book Katrin Froese juxtaposes the Daoist texts of Laozi and Zhuangzi with the thought of Nietzsche and Heidegger to argue that there is a need for rethinking the idea of a cosmological whole By moving away from the quest for certainty Froese suggests a way of philosophizing that does not seek to capture the whole but rather becomes a means of affirming a connection to it one that celebrates difference rather than eradicating it Human beings have a vague awareness of the infinite but they are nevertheless finite beings Froese maintains that rather than bemoaning the murkiness of knowledge the thinkers considered here celebrate the creativity and tendency to wander through that space of not knowing or in between ness However for Nietzsche and the early Heidegger this in between ness can often produce a sense of meaninglessness that sends individuals on a frenetic quest to mark out space that is uniquely their own Laozi and Zhuangzi on the other hand paint a portrait of the self that provides openings for others rather than deliberately forging an identity that it can claim as its own In this way human beings can become joyful wanderers that revel in the movements of the Dao and are comfortable with their own finitude Froese also suggests that Nietzsche and Heidegger are philosophers at a crossroads for they both exemplify the modern emphasis on self creation and at the same time share the Daoist insight into the perils of excessive egoism that can lead to misguided attempts to master the world **Cultural Beings** Yuval Lurie, 2021-12-28 Human beings are a cultural species This predicament enables them to take on many different cultural identities all of which transcend the bounds of natural behavior of other species To contemplate this predicament through philosophy is to reflect on such questions as What makes cultural forms of life possible What is encompassed in them What lies at their core What distinguishes them from natural forms of life What brings them about sustains and causes them to change Philosophical answers to these questions predate abstract ways of thinking as they are sometimes embedded in ancient mythical and religious narratives Such is the story told in the first three chapters of the book of Genesis in the Bible revealing how human beings became the cultural beings that they are This study suggests how that ancient and most celebrated story in the literature of the West may be read as harboring insightful philosophical observations on the cultural nature of human beings

It first focuses on the very concept of cultural forms of life revealing its complicated conceptual links to natural forms of life. It then offers an interpretive framework for reading mythical symbolic narratives. Using these ideas it provides a philosophical reading of the Biblical narrative disclosing it to harbor a metaphysically oriented conception of nature and two insightful philosophical overviews of the cultural nature of human beings. Both overviews endow human beings with an ability to manipulate nature but in different ways: the first by subjugating parcels of nature to human will; the second by subjugating human beings themselves to a value-laden conception of things and ethical forms of life. Thus human beings are portrayed as natural creatures possessed of a cultural nature that enables them to transform nature and recreate themselves through their unique cultural predicament.
