Ponto, 2012-02 With firm foundations dating only from the 1950s algebraic topology is a relatively young area of mathematics There are very few textbooks that treat fundamental topics beyond a first course and many topics now essential to the field are not treated in any textbook J Peter May s A Concise Course in Algebraic Topology addresses the standard first course material such as fundamental groups covering spaces the basics of homotopy theory and homology and cohomology In this sequel May and his coauthor Kathleen Ponto cover topics that are essential for algebraic topologists and others interested in algebraic topology but that are not treated in standard texts They focus on the localization and completion of topological spaces model categories and Hopf algebras The first half of the book sets out the basic theory of localization and completion of nilpotent spaces using the most elementary treatment the authors know of It makes no use of simplicial techniques or model categories and it provides full details of other necessary preliminaries With these topics as motivation most of the second half of the book sets out the theory of model categories which is the central organizing framework for homotopical algebra in general Examples from topology and homological algebra are treated in parallel A short last part develops the basic theory of bialgebras and Hopf algebras **Algebraic Topology** Tammo tom Dieck, 2008 This book is written as a textbook on algebraic topology The first part covers the material for two introductory courses about homotopy and homology The second part presents more advanced applications and concepts duality characteristic classes homotopy groups of spheres bordism The author recommends starting an introductory course with homotopy theory For this purpose classical results are presented with new elementary proofs Alternatively one could start more traditionally with singular and axiomatic homology Additional chapters are devoted to the geometry of manifolds cell complexes and fibre bundles A special feature is the rich supply of nearly 500 exercises and problems Several sections include topics which have not appeared before in textbooks as well as simplified proofs for some important results Prerequisites are standard point set topology as recalled in the first chapter elementary algebraic notions modules tensor product and some terminology from category theory The aim of the book is to introduce advanced undergraduate and graduate master s students to basic tools concepts and results of algebraic topology Sufficient background material from geometry and algebra is included *Cubical Homotopy Theory* Brian A. later largely codified in the notion of a model category This core includes the notions of fibration and cofibration CW complexes long fiber and cofiber sequences loop spaces and suspensions and so on Brown s representability theorems show that homology and cohomology are also contained in classical homotopy theory This text develops classical homotopy theory from a modern point of view meaning that the exposition is informed by the theory of model categories and that homotopy limits and colimits play central roles The exposition is guided by the principle that it is generally preferable to prove topological results using topology rather than algebra The language and basic theory of homotopy limits and colimits make it possible to penetrate deep into the subject with just the rudiments of algebra The text does reach advanced territory including the Steenrod algebra Bott periodicity localization the Exponent Theorem of Cohen Moore and Neisendorfer and Miller s Theorem on the Sullivan Conjecture Thus the reader is given the tools needed to understand and participate in research at part of the current frontier of homotopy theory Proofs are not provided outright Rather they are presented in the form of directed problem sets To the expert these read as terse proofs to novices they are challenges that draw them in and help them to thoroughly understand the arguments Motivic Homotopy Theory Bjorn Ian Dundas, Marc Levine, P.A.
