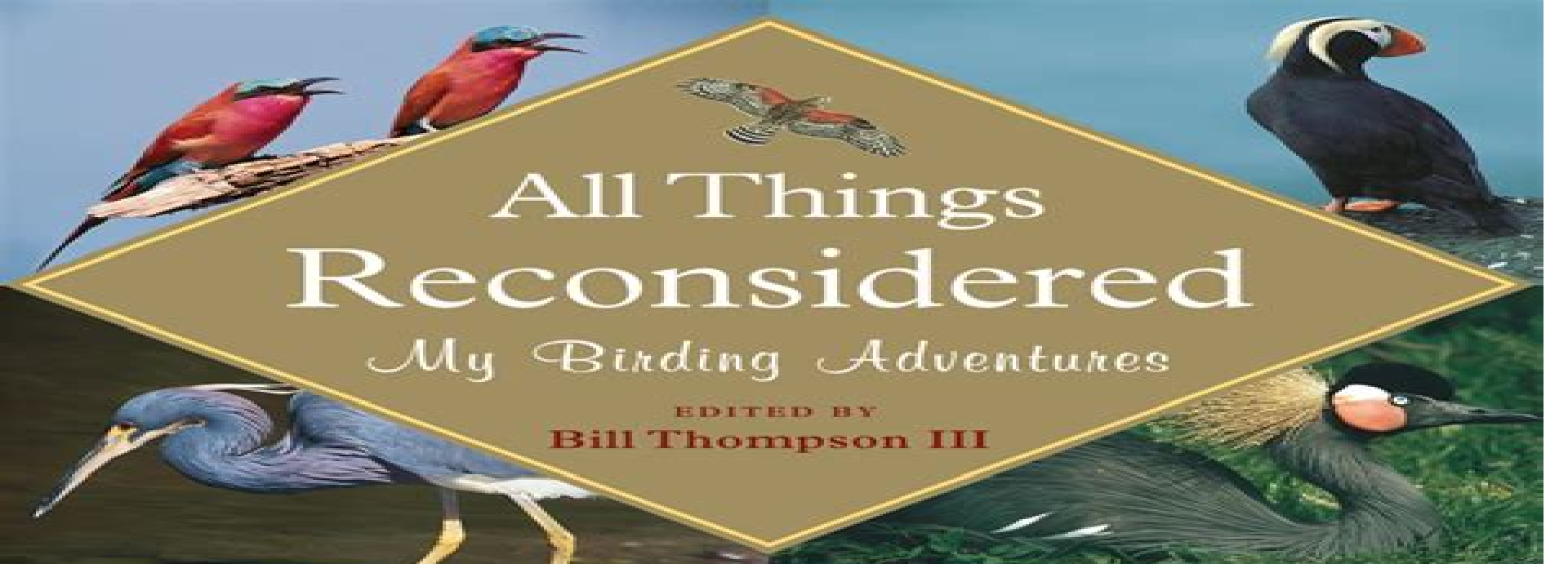




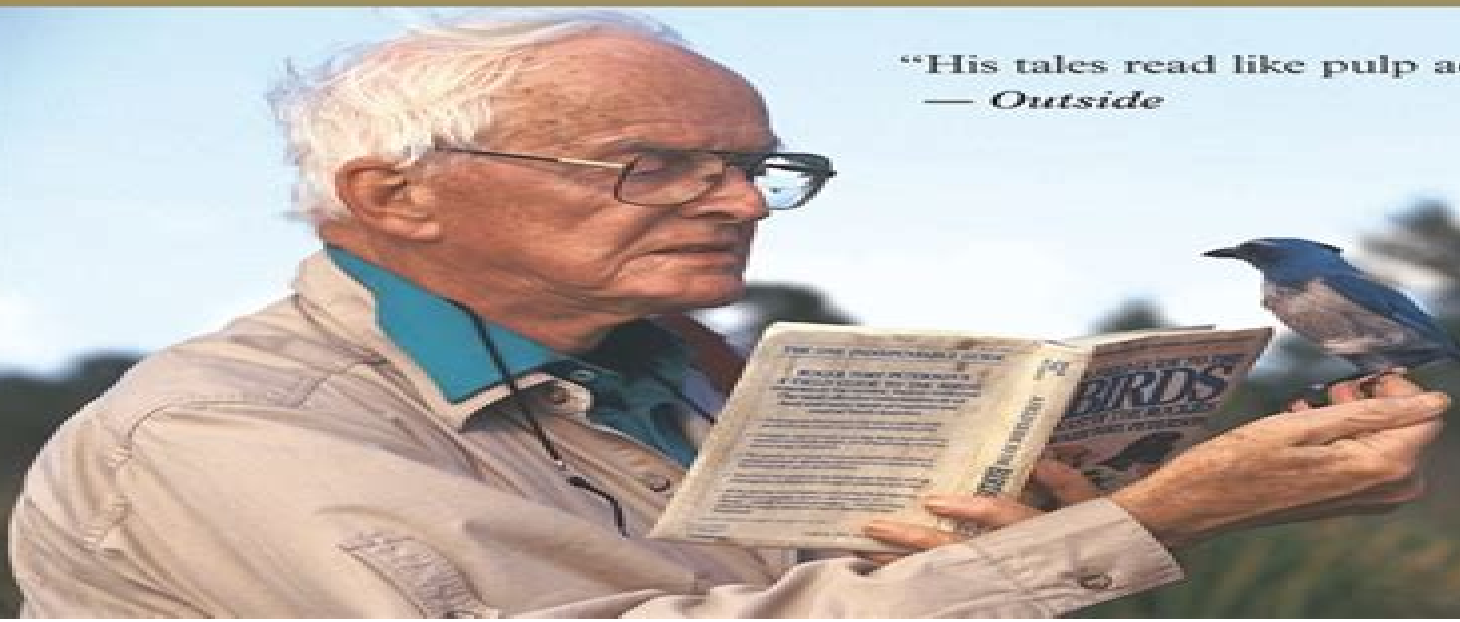

Roosevelt, an avid birder, was born a hunter and died a conservationist.
