Angel Island Erika Lee, Judy Yung, 2010-08-30 From 1910 to 1940 over half a million people sailed through the Golden Gate hoping to start a new life in America But they did not all disembark in San Francisco instead most were ferried across the bay to the Angel Island Immigration Station For many this was the real gateway to the United States For others it was a prison and their final destination before being sent home In this landmark book historians Erika Lee and Judy Yung both descendants of immigrants detained on the island provide the first comprehensive history of the Angel Island Immigration Station Drawing on extensive new research including immigration records oral histories and inscriptions on the barrack walls the authors produce a sweeping yet intensely personal history of Chinese paper sons Japanese picture brides Korean students South Asian political activists Russian and Jewish refugees Mexican families Filipino repatriates and many others from around the world Their experiences on Angel Island reveal how America's discriminatory immigration policies changed the lives of immigrants and transformed the nation A place of heartrending history and breathtaking beauty the Angel Island Immigration Station is a National Historic Landmark and like Ellis Island it is recognized as one of the most important sites where America's immigration history was made This fascinating history is ultimately about America itself and its complicated relationship to immigration a story that continues today

Voices of Angel Island Charles Egan, 2020-12-10 Voices of Angel Island is a historical and literary anthology of the writings of immigrants detained at Angel Island designed to provide a conduit for readers today to connect with early 20th century perspectives on the process of becoming American The Angel Island Immigration Station in San Francisco Bay has been called the Ellis Island of the West but its purpose was quite different It was primarily a detention center established in large part to discourage immigration by Asians The station barracks contain an extraordinary archive hundreds of poems and prose records in half a dozen languages are on the walls inscribed by immigrant detainees between 1910 and 1940 and by POWs and enemy aliens during World War II Charles Egan draws on over a decade's work deciphering the wall inscriptions by Japanese Chinese Korean European and other detainees to assemble a selection of their writings in

this book alongside literary materials from Bay Area ethnic newspapers While each inscription tells the story of an individual taken together they illuminate the historical economic and cultural forces that shaped the lives of ordinary people in the early 20th century
