Lebowitz, 2012-08 What was real socialism the term which originated in twentieth century socialist societies for the purpose of distinguishing them from abstract theoretical socialism In this volume Michael A Lebowitz considers the nature tendencies and contradictions of those societies Beginning with the constant presence of shortages within real socialism Lebowitz searches for the inner relations which generate these patterns He finds these in particular in what he calls vanguard relations of production a relation which takes the apparent form of a social contract where workers obtain benefits not available to their counterparts in capitalism but lack the power to decide within the workplace and society While these societies were able to claim major achievements in areas from health care to education to popular culture the separation of thinking and doing prevented workers from developing their capacities as fully developed human beings The relationship within real socialism between the vanguard as conductor and a conducted working class however did not only lead to the deformation of workers and those elements necessary for the building of socialism it also created the conditions in which enterprise managers emerged as an incipient capitalist class which was an immediate source of the crises of real socialism As he argued in The Socialist Alternative Real Human Development Lebowitz stresses the necessity to go beyond the hierarchy inherent in the relation of conductor and conducted and beyond the vanguard Marxism
