Aquinas on Emotion's Participation in Reason Nicholas Kahm, 2019-01-09. *Aquinas on Emotion's Participation in Reason* aims to present Aquinas's answer to the perennial and now popular question: In what way can the emotions be rational? For Aquinas, the starting point of this inquiry is Aristotle's claim *EN* I 13 that there are three parts to the soul: 1. the rational part, 2. the non-rational part which can participate in reason, and 3. the non-rational part that does not participate in reason. It is the extent to which the second part, the sense appetites, the seat of the emotions, participates in reason that the emotions can become rational. However, immediately after Aristotle introduces his tripartite division of the soul, he warns that one need not delve into the details of the division or the participation. Aquinas, however, ignores Aristotle and uses his precise metaphysics of participation within his sophisticated anthropology to great effect in his ethics. Unlike Aristotle, to fully understand Aquinas's thinking on how the emotions can become rational, we simply must delve into the kinds of precisions that Aristotle thinks are misplaced. When Aquinas's views emerge from these precisions, he has a surprisingly level-headed and commonsense view of how the emotions can become rational. On this point, he is more pessimistic than Aristotle and more optimistic than Kant; he is certainly not as is he is often thought to be the faithful follower of Aristotle and the polar opposite of Kant. Nicholas Kahm argues that Aquinas has a realistic and plausible view of how far reason can go in shaping our emotions. Furthermore, his plausible views can accommodate the serious current challenge raised against virtue ethics from social psychology. The method has mainly been a careful reading of primary texts, but unlike the rest of the scholarship on Aquinas's ethics, Kahm is particularly sensitive to Aquinas's historical and philosophical development.

The Guise of the Good Francesco Orsi, 2023-04-14. This is the first book to trace the doctrine of the guise of the good throughout the history of Western philosophy. The Passion of Love in the Summa Theologiae of Thomas Aquinas Daniel Joseph Gordon, 2023-05-19. This book is an introduction to three questions on love according to St. Thomas Aquinas, *Summa Theologiae* I-II qq. 26-28. These three questions reflect on the nature of love: q. 26, the causes of love; q. 27, and the effects of love; q. 28. It is thus an introduction to the entire phenomenon of love, both as a bodily passion and an act of the will. The purpose is to present the Thomistic and broadly scholastic account of human and divine love from a philosophical and theological perspective. The method is broadly exegetical, presenting a careful reading of the text and supplying the philosophical and theological background which the text of Aquinas assumes. The scope of the work is limited to three questions, ST I-II qq. 26-28. References to interpretative disputes of Aquinas and references to further resources in the secondary literature will be mostly limited to the footnotes, making the body of the text accessible to more readers.

Relational Intentionality: Brentano and the Aristotelian Tradition Hamid Taieb, 2018-12-28. This book sheds new light on the history of the philosophically crucial notion of intentionality, which accounts for one of the most distinctive aspects of our mental life: the fact that our thoughts are about objects. Intentionality is often described as a certain kind of relation. Intentionality accounts for the aboutness of a thought causality by contrast explains how the thought is generated and reference understood as a sort of similarity occurs when the object towards which the thought is directed exists Brentano claims to find some anticipation of his views in Aristotle This book argues that whether or not Brentano's interpretation of Aristotle is correct his claim is true of the Aristotelian tradition as a whole since followers of Aristotle more or less explicitly made some or all of Brentano's distinctions This is demonstrated through examination of some major figures of the Aristotelian tradition broadly understood including Alexander of Aphrodisias the Neoplatonic commentators Thomas Aquinas Duns Scotus and Francisco Suarez This book combines a longue dure approach focusing on the long term evolution of philosophical concepts rather than restricting itself to a specific author or period with systematic analysis in the history of philosophy By studying Brentano and the Aristotelian authors with theoretical sensitivity it also aims to contribute to our understanding of intentionality and cognate features of the mind
