Bodies on the Line Raphael Allison, 2014-12-01 *Bodies on the Line* offers the first sustained study of the poetry reading in its most formative period the 1960s Raphael Allison closely examines a vast archive of audio recordings of several key postwar American poets to explore the social and literary context of the sixties poetry reading which is characterized by contrasting differing styles of performance the humanist style and the skeptical strain The humanist style made mainstream by the Beats and their imitators is characterized by faith in the power of presence emotional communion and affect The skeptical strain emphasizes openness of interpretation and multivalent meaning a lack of stability or consistency and ironic detachment By comparing these two dominant styles of reading Allison argues that attention to sixties poetry readings reveals poets struggling between the kind of immediacy and presence that readings suggested and a private retreat from such performance based publicity one centered on the text itself Recordings of Robert Frost Charles Olson Gwendolyn Brooks Larry Eigner and William Carlos Williams all of whom emphasized voice breath and spoken language and who were inveterate professional readers in the sixties expose this struggle in often surprising ways In deconstructing assertions about the role and importance of the poetry reading during this period Allison reveals just how dramatic political and contentious poetry readings could be By discussing how to hear as well as read poetry *Bodies on the Line* offers startling new vantage points from which to understand American poetry since the 1960s as both performance and text **Emily Dickinson** Ann Beebe, 2022-03-03 The public is familiar with the Emily Dickinson stereotype an eccentric spinster in a white dress flitting about her father's house hiding from visitors But these associations are misguided and should be dismantled This work aims to remove some of the distorted myths about Dickinson in order to clear a path to her poetry The entries and short essays should open avenues of debate and individual critical analysis This companion gives both instructors and readers multiple avenues for study The entries and charts are intended to prompt ideas for classroom discussion and syllabus planning Whether the reader is first encountering Dickinson's poems or returning to them this book aims to inspire interpretative opportunities The entries and charts make connections between Dickinson poems ponder the significance of literary artistic historical political or social contexts and question the interpretations offered by others as they enter the never ending debates between Dickinson scholars **The Poetry of He Zhu (1052-1125)** Stuart Sargent, 2007-03-31 The Northern Song poet He Zhu is best known for his lyrics ci but also produced shi poetry of subtlety wit and feeling This study examines the latter as a response to the options available to a late eleventh century writer in the pentametrical and heptametrical forms of Ancient Verse Regulated Verse and Quatrains Numerous comparisons are made with Su Shi Huang Tingjian Du Fu and other important writers In a major advance over previous methodologies the author uses a clear system of metrical notation to show how sound patterns reveal the poet's artistic and emotional intentions This innovation and the author's other meticulous explorations of He Zhu's artistry allow us to experience Chinese poetry as never before From the reader's
