The results of so much labour have forged the identity of Eritrea jealously defended for decades and jealously guarded to this day Looking carefully in libraries among printed works dedicated to particular aspects of this identity numerous and some very important it is impossible to find a history of Eritrea that is scientifically complete and up to date This is a serious shortcoming Yet everything has remained impressed
