Between Love And Friendship:

Love and Friendship Eduardo A. Velásquez, 2003-01-01 *Love and Friendship* gathers the reflections of some of today's most preeminent political scientists, philosophers, historians, and students of literature and religion in an investigation of the most influential accounts of love and friendship in Western history. The collection begins with a discussion of classical philosophers such as Plato and Aristotle, moves through a wide array of modern philosophers among them Montaigne, Hobbes, Locke, and Rousseau, and concludes with contemporary/postmodern accounts of love and friendship. Taken together, the essays provide an unprecedented exploration of the most compelling and sovereign human affections and associations. Eduardo Velásquez's marvelous ambitious project succeeds as each thoughtful and engaging piece proves the depth of the intimate relationship between psychology and political life.

Love and Friendship in the Western Tradition James McEvoy, 2023-08-18 *Love and Friendship in the Western Tradition* comprises a collection of essays written over a 25-year period by the late Rev. Professor James McEvoy on the theme of friendship. The book traces the genesis and development of philosophical treatments of friendship from Greek philosophy through the Middle Ages to modern and postmodern philosophy. The collection's three major concerns are: 1) the history of philosophical discussions of friendship; 2) the role of friendship in the cultivation of the philosophical life; 3) the marginalization of friendship as a theme for philosophical reflection and practice in the modern period. As the author was primarily a medievalist, a great deal of the focus of the essays is on the development of the theme of friendship in the Middle Ages in the thought of Augustine, Aquinas, Aelred of Rievaulx, Henry of Ghent, Robert Grosseteste, etc. However, this focus, while a value in itself, also serves to connect philosophical perspectives on friendship from before and after the Middle Ages. It connects to the time before inasmuch as much of the work done on friendship in the Middle Ages is anchored in interpretations of Aristotle and Plato, and it connects to the time after by providing a counterpoint to the modern paradigm of what constitutes the philosophical life. The collection combines historical with thematic approaches to scholarship on this issue and is one of the only books of its kind to do so. It is perhaps unique in its historical sweep and will prove to be a canonical source for further research on this topic.

Dorsality David Wills, 2008 In this highly original book, David Wills rethinks not only our nature before all technology but also what we understand to be technology. Rather than considering the human being as something natural that then develops technology, Wills argues we should instead imagine an originary imbrication of nature and machine that begins with a dorsal turn, a turn that takes place behind our back, outside our field of vision. With subtle and insightful readings, Wills pursues this sense of what lies behind our idea of the human by rescuing Heidegger's thinking from a reductionist dismissal of technology, examining different angles on Levinas's face-to-face relation, and tracing a politics of friendship and sexuality in Derrida and Sade. He also analyzes versions of exile in Joyce's rewriting of Homer and Broch's rewriting of Virgil, and discusses how Freud and Rimbaud exemplify the rhetoric of soil and blood that underlies every attempt to draw lines between nations and discriminate between

peoples In closing Wills demonstrates the political force of rhetoric in a sophisticated analysis of Nietzsche's oft quoted declaration that God is dead Forward motion Wills ultimately reveals is an ideology through which we have favored the front what can be seen over the aspects of the human and technology that lie behind the back and in the spine what can be sensed otherwise and shows that this preference has had profound environmental political sexual and ethical consequences David Wills is professor of French and English at the University of Albany SUNY He is the author of Prosthesis and Matchbook Essays in Deconstruction as well as the translator of works by Jacques Derrida including The Gift of Death

immensely useful resource for other scholars and philosophers wishing to understand Kant's views on love Rae Langton University of Cambridge What did Immanuel Kant really think about love In Kant on Love P. R. Rinty provides the first systematic study of love in the philosophy of Kant Rinty argues that love is much more important to Kant than previously realised and that understanding love is actually essential for Kantian ethical life The study involves two interpretative main propositions First that love in Kant includes an underlying general division of love into love of benevolence and love of delight Further the study divides Kant's concept of love into several aspects of love such as self love sexual love and love of beauty love of God love of neighbor and love in friendship A chapter of the book is devoted to each of these aspects beginning with the lowest forms of self love as crude animality and moving gradually upwards towards idealised ethical notions of love One way or another the major aspects relate to the general division of love This analytical trajectory yields the second main proposition of the study Together the aspects of love reveal an ascent of love in Kant's thought Perhaps surprisingly for Kant love permeates human existence from the strongest impulses of nature to the highest ideals of morally deserved happiness

Theological reflection on friendship as a particular form of Christian love emerges in Holy Scripture and continues to be elaborated in the Christian tradition. However, love of friendship was at times absorbed into the other traditional understanding of love: love of God and of neighbor. After a philosophical historical study of the Greco Roman roots of friendship in moral reflection and how and to what extent this was appropriated in the Christian tradition, this book illustrates the transcendental character and the novelty of the Christian understanding of friendship found in Holy Scripture, focusing particularly on the most relevant texts in the Fourth Gospel where love and friendship stand to be important themes. It also shows how Saint Thomas Aquinas through his exegesis of the Fourth Gospel, his synthesis of the Christian tradition and his ability to rearticulate Christian theology through Aristotelian philosophy inimitably defines the theological virtue of *caritas* as friendship with God. In so doing, he depicts friendship as the finality, the *telos* of the Christian life. Finally, the book aims to show how the retrieval of a proper theology of friendship rooted in Holy Scripture and Christian tradition can enrich the life of an authentic Christian and contribute to the ongoing process of renewing moral theology.

The Politics of Sociability
Stefan-Ludwig Hoffmann, 2018-11-20. An ambitious original work. The Politics of Sociability is Stefan Ludwig Hoffmann's exploration of the social and political significance of Freemasonry in German history. Drawing on de Tocqueville's theory that without civic virtue there is no civil society and that civic virtue unfolds only through the social interaction between citizens, Hoffmann examines the critical link between Freemasonry and the evolution of German civil society in the late nineteenth century. The practice of Masonic sociability reflected an enlightened belief in the political significance of moral virtue for civil society; indeed, for humanity. Using a wealth of archival sources previously unavailable, Stefan Ludwig Hoffmann shows how Freemasonry became a social refuge for elevated and liberal-minded bourgeois men who felt attracted to its secret rituals and moral teachings. German Freemasons sought to reform self and society but Hoffmann argues ultimately failed to balance modern politics with a cosmopolitan ethos. Hoffmann illuminates a capacious history of the political effects of Enlightenment concepts and practices in a century marked by nationalism, social discord, and religious conflict. Stefan Ludwig Hoffmann is Assistant Professor of Modern History at Ruhr University Bochum.
