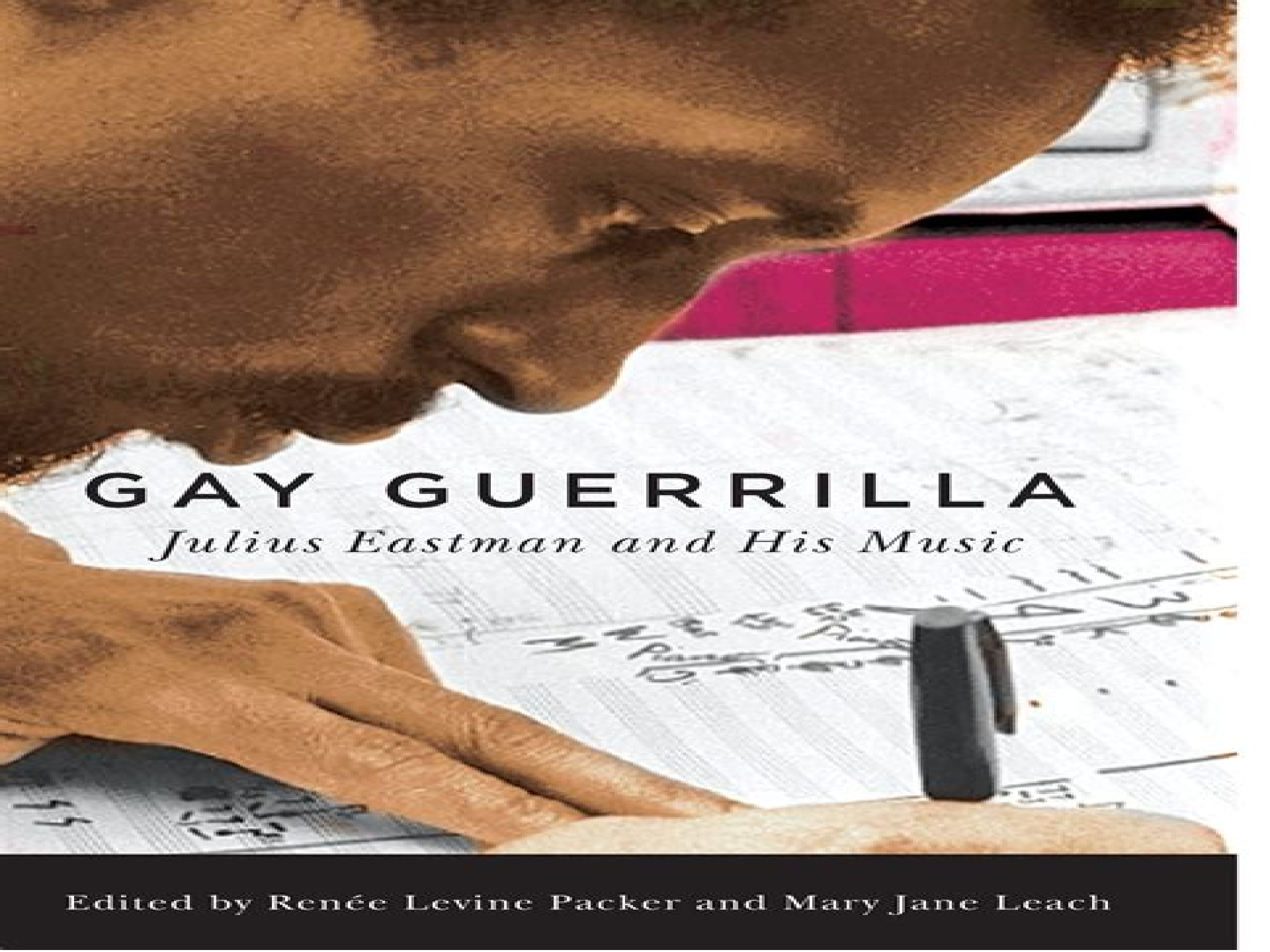

Gay Guerrilla Renée Levine Packer, Mary Jane Leach, 2015 **Gay Guerrilla** Renée Levine Packer, Mary Jane Leach, 2015 A compelling portrait of composer performer Julius Eastman's enigmatic and intriguing life and music Composer performer Julius Eastman 1940-90 was an enigma both comfortable and uncomfortable in the many worlds he inhabited black white gay straight classical music disco academia and downtown New York His music insistent and straightforward resists labels and seethes with a tension that resonates with musicians scholars and audiences today Eastman's provocative titles including *Gay Guerrilla* *Evil Nigger* *Crazy Nigger* and others assault us with his obsessions Eastman tested limits with his political aggressiveness as reflected in legendary scandals like his June 1975 performance of John Cage's *Song Books* which featured homoerotic interjections and the uproar over his titles at Northwestern University These episodes are examples of Eastman's persistence in pushing the limits of the acceptable in the highly charged arenas of sexual and civil rights In addition to analyses of Eastman's music the essays in *Gay Guerrilla* provide background on his remarkable life history and the era's social landscape The book presents an authentic portrait of a notable American artist that is compelling reading for the general reader as well as scholars interested in twentieth century American music American studies gay rights and civil rights This *Life of Sounds* Evenings for New Music in Buffalo received an ASCAP Deems Taylor Award for excellence Mary Jane Leach is a composer and freelance writer currently writing music and theatre criticism for the Albany Times Union

The Life and Music of Gérard Grisey Jeffrey Arlo Brown, 2023 The first biography of the composer Gérard Grisey shows how the artist's sensuality and rigor came together to form the musical genre known as spectralism The French composer Gérard Grisey 1946-98 changed the course of music history with his small but potent output Labeled spectral music his compositions looked to the physics of sound and the capacities of human perception for material and inspiration Born in Belfort Grisey was the son of a French Resistance veteran turned car mechanic and a homemaker His first instrument was as humble as his background the accordion But Grisey rose from his provincial background to the heights of his profession This first biography of Grisey traces his journey from rigid Catholicism to broader mysticism his studies in Olivier Messiaen's legendary composition class the development of the first spectral works in the 1970s Grisey's stint teaching at the University of California at Berkeley during which he suffered severe depression the development of his late post spectral style and his untimely death at the age of 52 shortly after completing his masterpiece on death the *Four Songs for Crossing the Threshold* Drawing on original archival research interviews with more than fifty of Grisey's colleagues friends and lovers and the study of previously overlooked sketches this biography shows the delirium and form at the heart of Grisey's life and art the structured sensuality that allowed him to revolutionize the music of the twentieth century *Rethinking Difference in Music Scholarship* Olivia Ashley Bloechl, Melanie Diane Lowe, Jeffrey Kallberg, 2015-01-08 This major essay collection takes a fresh look at how differences among people matter for music and musical thought **Weill, Blitzstein, and Bernstein** Rebecca

Schmid,2023 The first study to explore the crucial influence of Kurt Weill on operas and musicals by Marc Blitzstein and Leonard Bernstein Theodor Adorno famously proclaimed that the model of Kurt Weill could not be repeated Yet Weill s stage works set an inescapable precedent for composers on both sides of the Atlantic Rebecca Schmid explores how Weill s formal innovations in particular laid the groundwork for operas and musicals by Marc Blitzstein and Leonard Bernstein although both composers resisted or downplayed his aesthetic contribution to American tradition Comparative analysis based on Harold Bloom s Anxiety of Influence and other modes of intertextuality reveals that the principles of Weill s opera reform would catalyze an indigenous movement in sophisticated socially engaged music theatre Weill Blitzstein and Bernstein A Study of Influence focuses on works that represent different phases of Weill s mission to renew the genre of opera evolving from Die Dreigroschenoper to the musical play Lady in the Dark and the Broadway Opera Street Scene Blitzstein and Bernstein in turn defied formal boundaries with The Cradle Will Rock Regina Trouble in Tahiti Candide and West Side Story part of a short lived movement in mid twentieth century America that coincided with a renaissance for Weill s German period works following the premiere of Blitzstein s translation The Threepenny Opera under Bernstein s baton The unpublished A Prayer by Blecht for which Bernstein rejoined Stephen Sondheim and Jerome Robbins his collaborators on West Side Story deepens the connection of Bernstein s aesthetic to Weill

Interpretive Labor Kirsten Carithers,2025 Why did so many musicians in the postwar era engage with experimental practices and why do artists continue to do so today What happens when we acknowledge the work that goes into performing this repertoire What kind of work is it to be a contemporary musician anyway To address these questions Interpretive Labor Experimental Music at Work presents the theory of Interpretive Labor or the creative work of interpretation This book introduces and develops Interpretive Labor as grounded in a vast network of participants in new music between c 1960 and the present establishes several models of musical work and explores the myriad connections between music and labor in the neoliberal present Experimentalism s practitioners may rely on different codes and norms than most classical or popular musicians but the underlying work that individuals do to create understand prepare and produce their music is quite ordinary At the same time because these musicians did not initially have access to a normative performance practice the work involved is often especially pronounced and sometimes takes unusual forms The story of Interpretive Labor thus demonstrates the value of a marriage between labor studies and music studies and provides a novel conceptual framework for the economy of musical activities Its various forms can be instructive to anyone whose work involves some degree of creativity from computer programmers to social media influencers interior designers to event planners and of course musicians

Group Works Ethan Philbrick, 2023-04-25 An exciting new reflection on the role of artistic collaboration collectivism and the politics of group formation in the neoliberal era The artist and author Ethan Philbrick's *Group Works* reimagines the group by undertaking an historiographic archaeology of group aesthetics and politics Written against both phobic and romantic accounts of collectivity *Group Works* contends that the group emerges as a medium for artists when established forms of collective life break down Philbrick pairs group pieces in dance literature film and music from the 1960s and 1970s downtown Manhattan scene alongside a series of recent group experiments Simone Forti's dance construction *Huddle* 1961 is put into relation with contemporary reperformances of Forti's score and huddling as a feminist political tactic Samuel Delany's memoir of communal living *Heavenly Breakfast: An Essay on the Winter of Love 1969-78* speaks to performance artist Morgan Bassichis's 2017 communal musical adaptation of Larry Mitchell's 1977 text *The Faggots and Their Friends Between Revolutions* Lizzie Borden's experimental documentary of feminist collectivity *Regrouping* 1976 sits alongside visual artist Sharon Hayes's 2014 piece on Manhattan's Pier 54 *Women of the World Unite they said* and Julius Eastman's insurgent piece of chamber music for four pianos *Gay Guerrilla* 1979 resonates alongside contemporary projects that take up Eastman's legacy by artists such as Tiona Nekkia McClodden By analyzing works that articulate the politics of race gender and sexuality as questions of group formation Philbrick approaches the group not as a stable idealizable entity but as an ambivalent way to negotiate and contest shifting terms of associational life *Group Works* presents an engaging exploration of what happens when small groups become a material and medium for artistic and political experimentation

The Williamsburg Avant-Garde Cisco Bradley, 2023-02-03 In *The Williamsburg Avant Garde* Cisco Bradley chronicles the rise and fall of the underground music and art scene in the Williamsburg neighborhood of Brooklyn between the late 1980s and the early 2010s Drawing on interviews archival collections musical recordings videos photos and other ephemera Bradley explores the scene s social cultural and economic dynamics Building on the neighborhood s punk DIY approach and aesthetic Williamsburg s free jazz postpunk and noise musicians and groups from Mary Halvorson Zs and Nate Wooley to Matana Roberts Peter Evans and Darius Jones produced shows in a variety of unlicensed venues as well as in clubs and cafes At the same time pirate radio station free103point9 and music festivals made Williamsburg an epicenter of New York s experimental culture In 2005 New York s rezoning act devastated the community as gentrification displaced its participants farther afield in Brooklyn and in Queens With this portrait of Williamsburg Bradley not only documents some of the most vital music of the late twentieth and early twenty first centuries he helps readers better understand the formation vibrancy and life span of experimental music and art scenes everywhere
