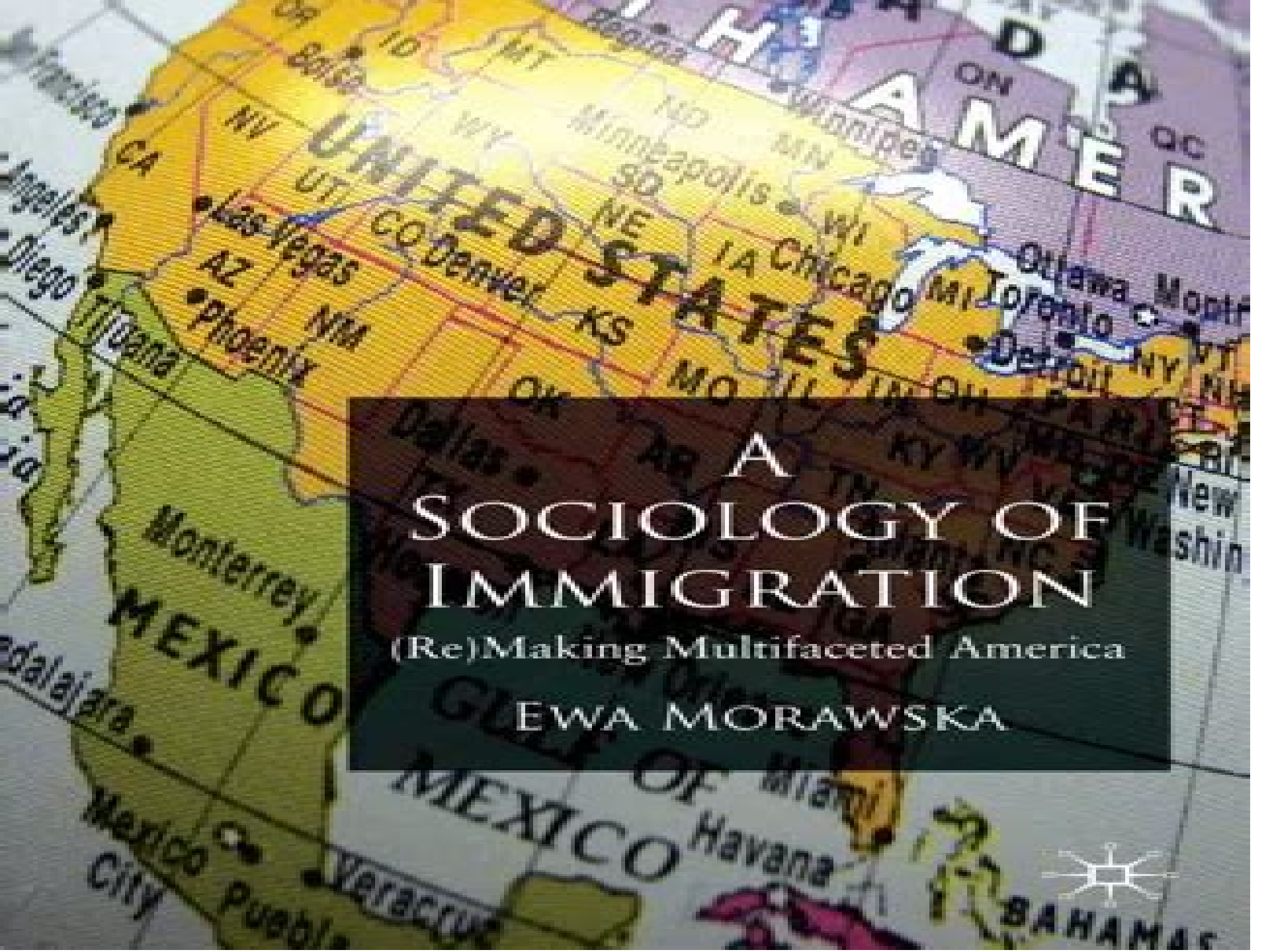
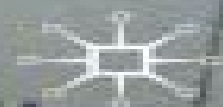

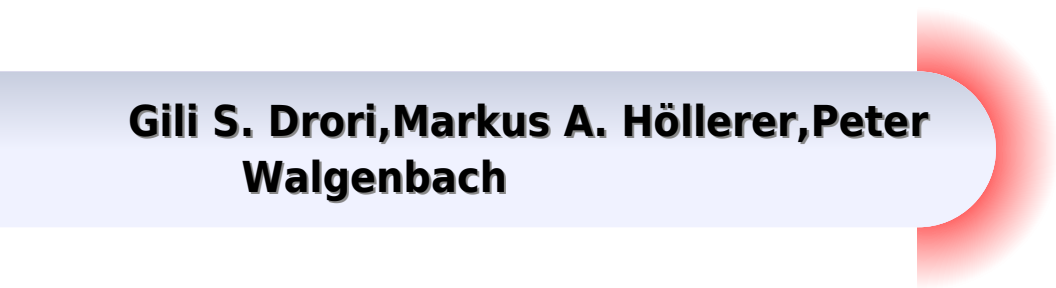

It examines four major issues informing current sociological studies of immigration: mechanisms and effects of international migration, processes of immigrants' assimilation and transnational engagements, and the adaptation patterns of the second generation.

Migrant Marginality Philip Kretsedemas, Jorge Capetillo-Ponce, Glenn Jacobs, 2013-08-15 This edited book uses migrant marginality to problematize several different aspects of global migration. It examines how many different societies have defined their national identities, cultural values, and terms of political membership through and in opposition to constructions of migrants and migration. The book includes case studies from Western and Eastern Europe, North America, and the Caribbean. It is organized into thematic sections that illustrate how different aspects of migrant marginality have unfolded across several national contexts. The first section of the book examines the limitations of multicultural policies that have been used to incorporate migrants into the host society. The second section examines anti-immigrant discourses and get-tough enforcement practices that are geared toward excluding and removing criminalized aliens. The third section examines some of the gendered dimensions of migrant marginality. The fourth section examines the way that racially marginalized populations have engaged the politics of immigration, constructing themselves as either migrants or natives. The book offers researchers, policy makers, and students an appreciation for the various policy concerns, ethical dilemmas, and political and cultural antagonisms that must be engaged in order to properly understand the problem of migrant marginality.

Antisemitism and the Constitution of Sociology Marcel Stoetzler, 2014-07-01 Modern antisemitism and the modern discipline of sociology not only emerged in the same period but antagonism and hostility between the two discourses notwithstanding also overlapped and complemented each other. Sociology emerged in a society where modernization was often perceived as destroying unity and social cohesion. Antisemitism was likewise a response to the modern age, offering in its vilifications of the Jew an explanation of society's deficiencies and crises. *Antisemitism and the Constitution of Sociology* is a collection of twelve essays providing a comparative analysis of modern antisemitism and the rise of sociology. This volume addresses three key areas: the strong influence of writers of Jewish background and the rising tide of antisemitism on the formation of sociology; the role of antisemitism in the historical development of sociology through its treatment by leading figures in the field such as Emile Durkheim, Talcott Parsons, and Theodor W. Adorno; and the discipline's development in the aftermath of the Nazi Holocaust. Together, the essays provide a fresh perspective on the history of sociology and the role that antisemitism, Jews, fascism, and the Holocaust played in shaping modern social theory.

Before We Disappear into Oblivion Nina Bogdan, 2025-05-06 The October 1917 Russian Revolution and the subsequent Civil War triggered a mass exodus from Russia. Thousands boarded ships heading for California. *Before We Disappear into Oblivion* chronicles the struggles of members of the Russian diaspora in San Francisco and northern

California as they built communities and negotiated their acculturation into American society Nina Bogdan challenges the stereotype of the White Russian migr as an aristocrat in exile revealing the diversity within California s Russian communities in terms of social backgrounds political affiliations and geographic origins Bogdan details the historic Russian presence in northern California particularly Fort Ross and examines how migr s incorporated this presence into their strategies and tactics used to establish a foundation for community while developing their Russian American identity Consulting Russian language sources generated by the diaspora alongside American public discourse and thousands of government documents Bogdan traces the divergent paths Russian migr s took to become or not become middle class white Americans a century prior to the latest mass exodus of Russians from their homeland in 2022 Set against a backdrop of national and global events the Great Depression World War II McCarthyism and the Cold War Before We Disappear into Oblivion explores the factors that shaped the Americanization of one ethnic group in an environment where cultural affiliation became submerged in favour of a constructed racial identity
