- 1. Virus An infectious particle consisting of genes packaged in a protein coat
- Structure of a Virus:
 - a. Viruses are not cells
 - Virus Very small infectious particle consisting of nucleic acid enclosed in a protein coat and a membranous envelope
- 3. Viral Genome consists of ...
 - a. Double or Single stranded DNA OR.
 - b. Double or Single stranded RNA
 - i. The genome A single linear or circular molecule of the nucleic acid.
- Bacteriophage Also called phages, are viruses that infect bacteria
 - Have an elongated capsid head that encloses their DNA
 - A protein tail piece attaches the phage to the host and injects the phage DNA inside
- Lytic Cycle A phage replicative cycle that culminates in the death of the host cell
 - a. Produces new phages and lyses (breaks open) the host's cell wall, releasing the progeny viruses
 - b. Virulent Phage A phage that reproduces only by the lytic cycle
- Lysogenic Cycle Replicates the phage genome without destroying the host
 - The viral DNA molecule is incorporated into the host cell's chromosome
 - Temperate Phages Phages that use both the lytic and lysogenic cycles
- HIV The retrovirus that causes AIDS (acquired immunodeficiency syndrome)
 - Retroviruses use reverse transcriptase to copy their RNA genome into DNA
- 8. Provirus The viral DNA that is integrated into the host genome
 - a. Unlike a prophage, a provirus remains a permanent resident of the host cell
 - b. RNA polymerase transcribes the pro viral DNA into RNA molecules
 - c. The RNA molecules function both as mRNA for synthesis of viral proteins and as genomes for new virus particles released from the cell
- Chicken Pox A highly contagious viral infection causing an itchy, blister-like rash on the skin
- 10. AIDS A chronic, potentially life threatening condition caused by HIV. By damaging your immune system, HIV interferes with your body's ability to fight the organisms that cause disease
- 11. Measles A viral infection that's serious for small children but is easily preventable by a vaccine. The disease spreads through the air by respiratory droplets produced from coughing or sneezing.
- Influenza A common viral infection that can be deadly, especially in high risk groups.
 The flu attacks the lungs, nose, and throat
- 13. TB Tuberculosis (TB) is a disease caused by bacteria called Mycobacterium tuberculosis. The bacteria usually attack the lungs, but they can also damage other parts of the body
- Syphilis A bacterial infection usually spread by sexual contact that starts as a painless sore
