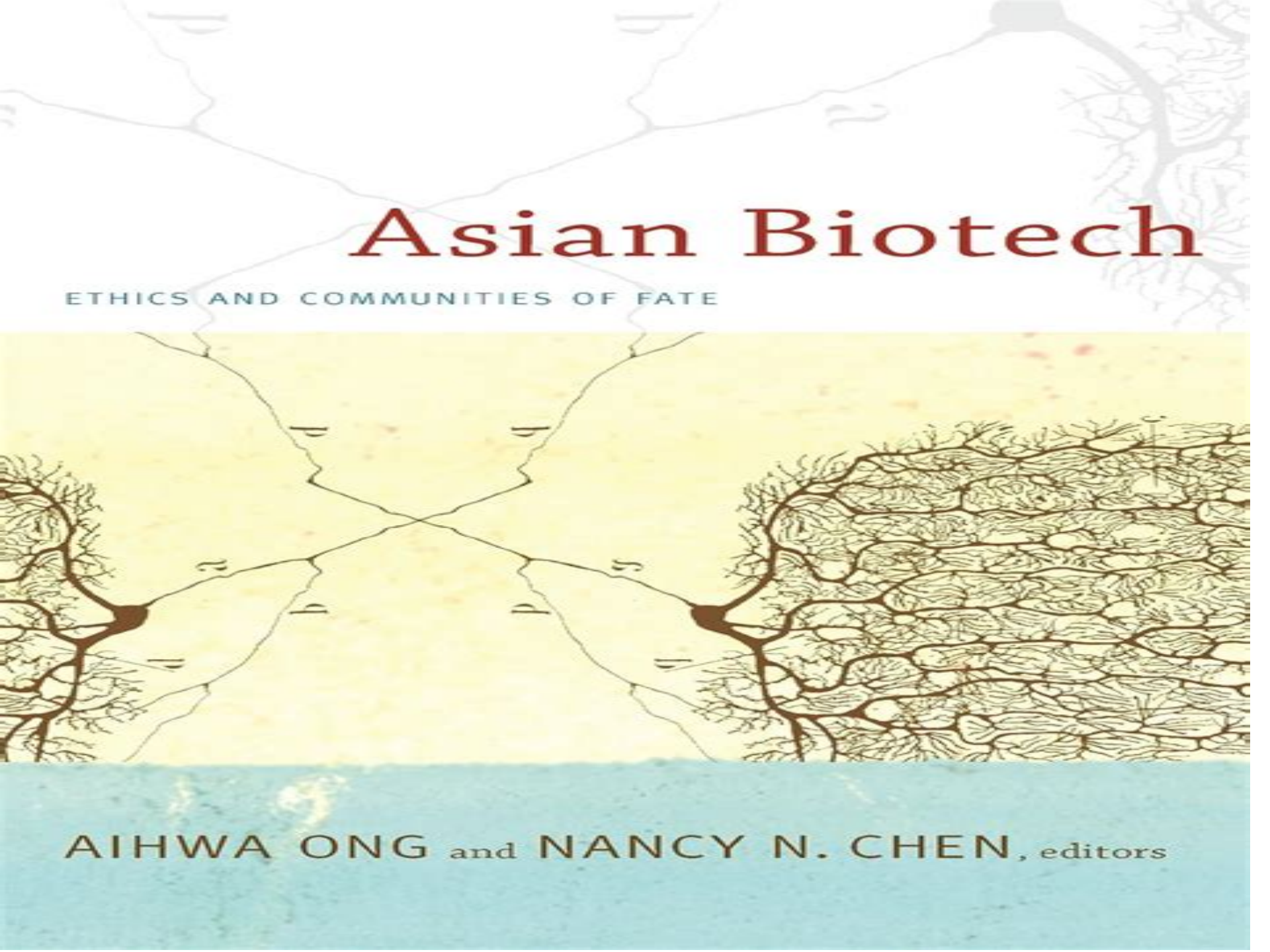

**Stem Cell Research in Asia** Margaret Sleeboom-Faulkner, 2016-03-22 The great hurry to realise promised cures in stem cell research requires regulation to guarantee bioethical research practices Yet increasingly similar national guidelines for stem cell research yields a range of diverging research practices This book shows how the different rationale of regulation affects stem cell research practices in Asia In low and medium income countries such as India and China the advancement of science has a different weight on the national agenda and the evaluation of scientific research is measured with a different yardstick depending on the political and national research

environment For developing countries the question of research funding into stem cell research healthcare and the donation of embryos fetuses and oocytes entail different considerations compared to in affluent welfare societies Moreover research institutions have different cultural and political histories so that the meaning of formal guidelines legislation and social rules may differ according to their various institutional settings This volume discusses the informal cultures social conventions and traditions that are crucial to the way in which stem cell research takes place in Asia This book was originally published as a special issue of *New Genetics and Society*

At the Limits of Cure Bharat Jayram Venkat, 2021-11-05 Can a history of cure be more than a history of how disease comes to an end In 1950s Madras an international team of researchers demonstrated that antibiotics were effective in treating tuberculosis But just half a century later reports out of Mumbai stoked fears about the spread of totally drug resistant strains of the disease Had the curable become incurable Through an anthropological history of tuberculosis treatment in India Bharat Jayram Venkat examines what it means to be cured and what it means for a cure to come undone *At the Limits of Cure* tells a story that stretches from the colonial period a time of sanatoria travel cures and gold therapy into a postcolonial present marked by antibiotic miracles and their failures Venkat juxtaposes the unraveling of cure across a variety of sites in idyllic hill stations and crowded prisons aboard ships and on the battlefield and through research trials and clinical encounters If cure is frequently taken as an ending of illness treatment and suffering more generally Venkat provides a foundation for imagining cure otherwise in a world of fading antibiotic efficacy

*South Asian Tissue Economies* Jacob Copeman, 2015-09-07 Questions of the social implications of biotechnology and biological exchange the extraction of human tissues such as blood skin and organs for testing storage and or distribution for therapeutic or research purposes have recently been brought strongly to the analytical fore across the social sciences This book focuses on the variegated biopolitical milieus of this kind of exchange specifically in South Asia It ranges widely theoretically thematically and regionally in examining South Asian variants of and engagements with diverse modes of biological exchange caste gender and blood donation in Pakistan DNA testing amongst a former Untouchable community in south India and amongst diasporic Indians in Houston Texas body cadaveric donation in India the use of fake blood in Bangladeshi cinema the mobilisation of blood hearts and ketones to protest the Indian government's failure to provide redress or care to victims of the 1984 Bhopal industrial disaster and blood based political portraits and petitions in south India In considering this complex of issues this book extends the parameters of classic accounts of the role of substance transactions in the production of South Asian personhood into investigations of the biopolitics and economies of substance that shape people and communities in diverse parts of the subcontinent describing findings that illuminate how local responses to the implementation of various kinds of tissue economy both reflect and also transform socio cultural values in South Asia This book was published as a special issue of *Contemporary South Asia*

Avian Reservoirs Frédéric Keck, 2020-01-17 After experiencing the SARS outbreak in 2003 Hong Kong Singapore and Taiwan all invested in various

techniques to mitigate future pandemics involving myriad cross species interactions between humans and birds In some locations microbiologists allied with veterinarians and birdwatchers to follow the mutations of flu viruses in birds and humans and create preparedness strategies while in others public health officials worked toward preventing pandemics by killing thousands of birds In *Avian Reservoirs* Frédéric Keck offers a comparative analysis of these responses tracing how the anticipation of bird flu pandemics has changed relations between birds and humans in China Drawing on anthropological theory and ethnographic fieldwork Keck demonstrates that varied strategies dealing with the threat of pandemics stockpiling vaccines and samples in Taiwan simulating pandemics in Singapore and monitoring viruses and disease vectors in Hong Kong reflect local geopolitical relations to mainland China In outlining how interactions among pathogens birds and humans shape the way people imagine future pandemics Keck illuminates how interspecies relations are crucial for protecting against such threats

**Biolegality** Sonja van Wichelen, Marc de Leeuw, 2024-06-26 This book provides a comprehensive analysis of the empirical and theoretical problems posed by the encounter between law and biology in the twenty first century How does biotechnology and new bioscientific knowledge affect our legal institutions our sense of justice and our ways of relating to one another To answer these questions authors Marc de Leeuw and Sonja van Wichelen examine the complex and often contested ways in which biotechnology and biological knowledge are reworked by with and against legal knowledge As this book shows recent developments in the life sciences including molecular biology immunology and the neurosciences and their applications in forensics medicine and agriculture test longstanding legal forms such as property personhood parenthood and collective identity ultimately constituting the current field of biolegality The authors argue that these biolegal contestations represent philosophical and anthropological challenges to existing understandings of exchange self kinship and community By addressing how biology and law inform new ways of relating and knowing the book proposes a programmatic intervention asserting the pivotal role the study of biolegality plays in advancing social and political theory

**Fungible Life** Aihwa Ong, 2016-10-13 In *Fungible Life* Aihwa Ong explores the dynamic world of cutting edge bioscience research offering critical insights into the complex ways Asian bioscientific worlds and cosmopolitan sciences are entangled in a tropical environment brimming with the threat of emergent diseases At biomedical centers in Singapore and China scientists map genetic variants disease risks and biomarkers mobilizing ethnicized Asian bodies and health data for genomic research Their differentiation between Chinese Indian and Malay DNA makes fungible Singapore's ethnic stratified databases that come to represent majority populations in Asia By deploying genomic science as a public good researchers reconfigure the relationships between objects peoples and spaces thus rendering Asia itself as a shifting entity In Ong's analysis Asia emerges as a richly layered mode of entanglements where the population's genetic pasts anxieties and hopes shared genetic weaknesses and embattled genetic futures intersect Furthermore her illustration of the contrasting methods and goals of the Biopolis biomedical center in Singapore and BGI Genomics in China raises questions about the future
