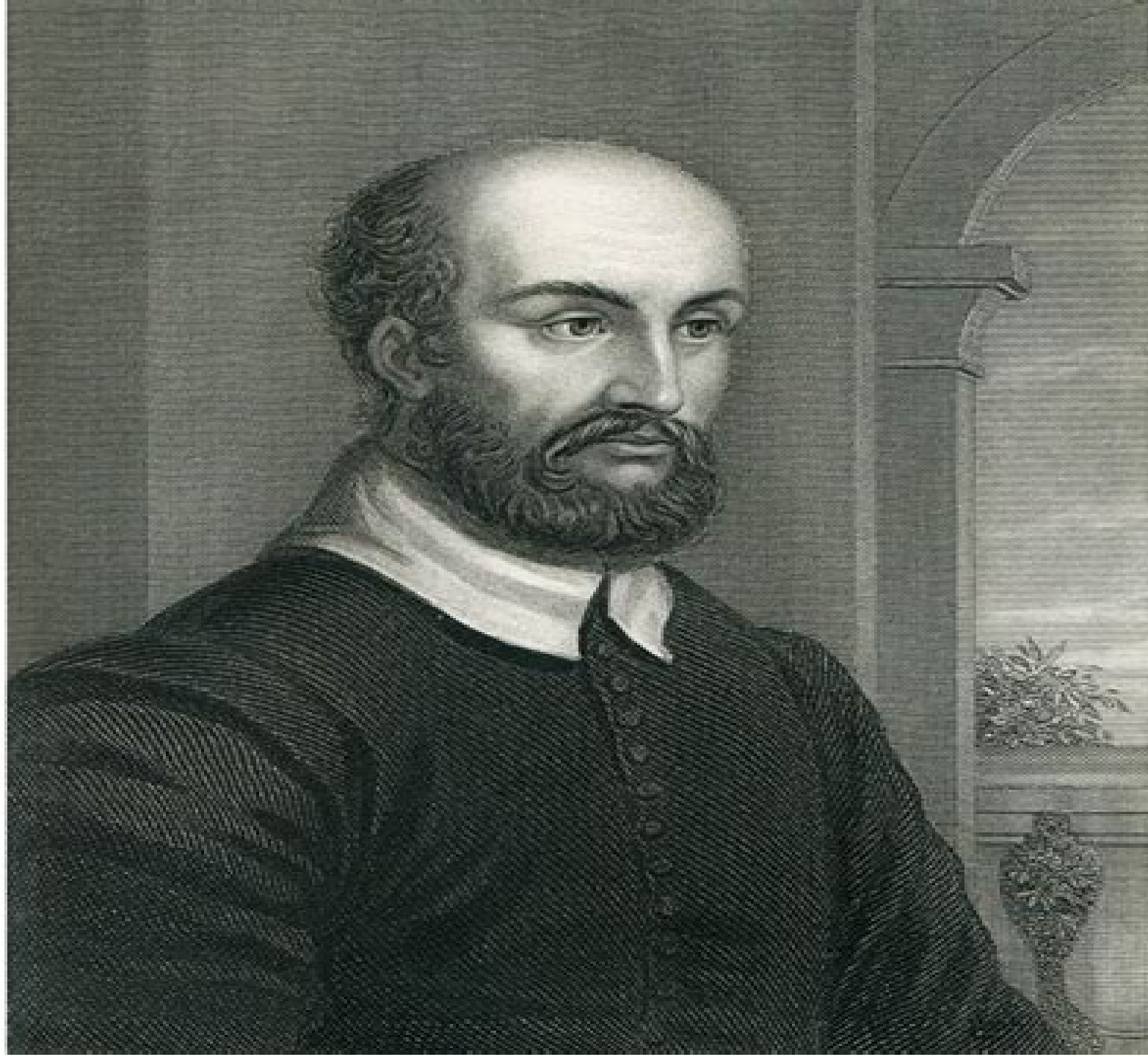

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Venice and the Renaissance Manfredo Tafuri, 1995-03-27 Pursuing the intersections of Venetian culture from the beginning of the sixteenth century through the first decades of the seventeenth Manfredo Tafuri develops a story crowded with characters and full of surprises He engages the doges Andrea Gritti and Leonardo Dona architects and artists Sansovino Serlio Palladio and Scamozzi and scientists Francesco Barozzi and Galileo He records the battle that was fought for architecture as metaphor for absolute truth and good government and contrasts these with the myths that inspired them

Chiswick House Gardens David Jacques, 2022-03-01 The grounds at Chiswick House are amongst the most iconic of all the historic gardens of Europe In the 1720s they reflected Lord Burlington's innovative ideas on Palladianism and antique gardens whilst the area transformed by William Kent to give a rustic appearance in the early 1730s has been recognised as one of or perhaps the birthplace of the landscape garden The grounds were periodically brought to the forefront of taste reaching another high point as the venue for spectacular garden parties under the 6th Duke of Devonshire As a garden of many periods it has given rise to passionate national debates since World War II on the principles of restoration and as a public park it has been an important project assisted by the National Lottery Heritage Fund Its renewed high state of keeping and its tranquil beauty belies its deep history of intellectual debate social tensions and practical difficulties The book concentrates on the four main periods when Chiswick gardens were in the national spotlight two when being in the forefront of taste and two concerning the restorations the first being in the 1950s when the whole question of garden restoration was entirely new The second restoration on and off since 1988 intersects with the development of a philosophical stance and national policy on the restoration of parks and gardens There is much of interest for art and architectural historians garden historians social historians and those local and international visitors who enjoy the finest public park in West London

Picturing Machines 1400-1700 Wolfgang Lefevre,2023-12-26 How technical drawings shaped early engineering practice Technical drawings by the architects and engineers of the Renaissance made use of a range of new methods of graphic representation These drawings among them Leonardo da Vinci s famous drawings of mechanical devices have long been studied for their aesthetic qualities and technological ingenuity but their significance for the architects and engineers themselves is seldom considered The essays in *Picturing Machines 1400 1700* take this alternate perspective and look at how drawing shaped the practice of early modern engineering They do so through detailed investigations of specific images looking at over 100 that range from sketches to perspective views to thoroughly constructed projections In early modern engineering practice drawings were not merely visualizations of ideas but acted as models that shaped ideas *Picturing Machines* establishes basic categories for the origins purposes functions and contexts of early modern engineering illustrations then treats a series of topics that not only focus on the way drawings became an indispensable means of engineering but also reflect the main stages in their historical development The authors examine the social interaction conveyed by early machine images and their function as communication between practitioners the knowledge either conveyed or presupposed by technical drawings as seen in those of Giorgio Martini and Leonardo drawings that required familiarity with geometry or geometric optics including the development of architectural plans and technical illustrations that bridged the gap between practical and theoretical mechanics [Topos in Utopia: A peregrination to early modern utopianism's space](#) Sotirios Triantafyllos,2021-09-07 *Topos in Utopia* examines early modern literary utopias and intentional communities social and cultural conception of space Starting from Thomas More s seminal work published in 1516 and covering a period of three centuries until the emergence of Enlightenment s *euchronia* this work provides a thorough yet
