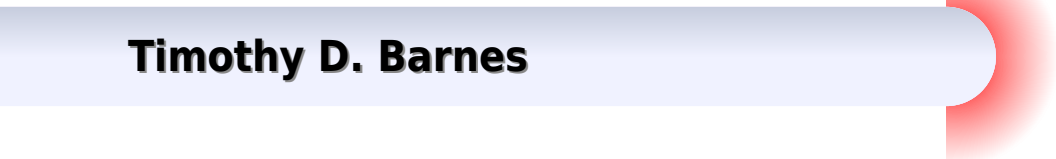

Atmospheric Halos Walter Tape, 2013-03-15 Published by the American Geophysical Union as part of the Antarctic Research Series Volume 64 Archdeacon Stuck was seeing halos formed in moonlight Their daytime counterparts are surprisingly common not only in the arctic but in temperate climates as well Many halos are possible forming arcs of colored or white light almost anywhere in the sky Their occasional brilliance variety and exotic shapes have impressed skywatchers for centuries This book introduces halos and tries to convey some of their beauty It tells much of what is known about them how they arise how so many are possible and why some are rare while others occur every few days or so No such insights of course are necessary for the enjoyment of a halo display indeed an elaborate display is one of Nature's wonders Nevertheless understanding can add to enjoyment especially since the makings of a great display turn out to be as remarkable as the display itself

Starr, Graeme Stephens, 2002-01-24 Cirrus clouds are high thin tropospheric clouds composed predominately of ice In the last ten years considerable work has shown that cirrus is widespread more common than previously believed and has a significant impact on climate and global change As the next generation weather satellites are being designed the impact of cirrus on remote sensing and the global energy budget must be recognized and accommodated This book the first to be devoted entirely to cirrus clouds captures the state of knowledge of cirrus and serves as a practical handbook as well Each chapter is based on an invited review talk presented at Cirrus a meeting hosted by the Optical Society of America and co sponsored by the American Geophysical Union and the American Meteorological Society
