Selected Plays of Padraic Colum Sanford Sternlicht, 2006-08-17 At the age of twenty three Padraic Colum 1881 1972 was one of the founding fathers of the Abbey Theatre His contribution to the development of Irish drama continued until his voluntary exile to America in 1914 His play Broken Soil 1903 was the first commercial success at the Abbey and it established the long lived tradition of the peasant play on the Irish stage This collection comprises the three major forms of his dramatic art The Land 1905 Betrayal 1912 and two of his five Noh plays a five play cycle containing poetry and prose following the Yeats and Japanese Model Glendalough based on the career of Charles Stewart Parnell and Monasterboice based on the early life of Colum's lifelong friend James Joyce
