- Big civil war photographer,
- Since the cameras took time to fully render, photos of the battle in action couldn't be taken, so he would take photos after the battle of the corpses.
- For the first time civilians were subject to the horrors of war
- Photos were used as propaganda

3. Jefferson Davis

- President of the confederacy
- Not in favor of succession
- Economic interest of the west. Sec. of war. Timid leadership. Southern states were divided about him.

4. Emancipation Proclamation

- Freed.... Absolutely nobody
- "Freed" slaves in the confederacy, but not those under union control or in border states.
- The confederacy saw itself as a new country, so they didn't have to follow the rules of the union.
- It was passed Jan 1, 1863

- Winchester Rifle: More than 1 shot at a time + more accurate shot
- Ironclads: Wood ships in Iron armor
- Torpedos + Submarines: Made by south, CSS Hunly, not successful, 1st submarine
