Assassins Boris Volodarsky, 2020-02-19 A look at the events surrounding the 2006 poisoning of a former Russian security officer in Great Britain In November 1998 Alexander Litvinenko a former lieutenant colonel of the Russian security

service or FSB along with several former colleagues publicly stated that their superiors had instigated an assassination attempt on a Russian tycoon and oligarch Following his subsequent arrest and failed trials Litvinenko fled to London where having been granted asylum he worked as a journalist and writer as well as acting as a consultant for the British intelligence services Eight years later Litvinenko's past caught up with him when he was assassinated in London On November 1 2006 Litvinenko was suddenly taken ill and hospitalized He passed away twenty two days later Significant amounts of a rare highly toxic element were subsequently found in his body Before his death Litvinenko had said You may succeed in silencing one man but the howl of protest from around the world Mr Putin will reverberate in your ears for the rest of your life Author Boris Volodarsky who was consulted by the Metropolitan Police during the investigation and remains in close contact with Litvinenko's widow details the events surrounding Litvinenko's murder Volodarsky updates the story referring to the findings of the official British inquiry on the release of which Prime Minister David Cameron condemned Putin for presiding over state sponsored murder The author proves that the Litvinenko's poisoning is just one of many Some of these assassinations or attempted assassinations are already known others are revealed by him for the first time

Sara Schatz, 2011-02-28. *Murder and Politics in Mexico* studies the causes of political killings in Mexico's liberalization/democratization within the larger context of political repression. Mexico's democratization process has entailed a little-known but highly significant cost of human lives in pre and post election violence. The majority of these crimes remain in a state of impunity; in other words, no person had been charged with the crime and/or no investigation of it had occurred. This has several consequences for Mexican politics when the level of violence is extreme and when political killings that are systematic and invasive are involved, this could indicate a real fracture in the democratic system. This book analyzes several dimensions regarding impunity and political crime, more specifically the political killings of members of the PRD in the post 1988 period in Mexico. The main argument proposed in this book is that impunity for political killings is a structured system requiring one central precondition, namely the failure of the legal system to function as a system of restraint for killings. Dr. Schatz's research finds that political assassinations are indeed rational, targeted actions but they do not occur within an institutional vacuum. Political assassinations are calculated strategies of action aimed at eliminating political rivals. As a form of interpersonal violence, political assassination involves direct or implied authorization from political leaders, the availability of assassins for hire, and the willingness of some political leaders to utilize them against political opponents. Violent interactions between political parties combined with judicial system ineffectiveness. A corrupt legal system facilitates the use of political assassination and explains the persistence of impunity for political murder over time. To reduce political violence in the transition to electoral democracy, specific institutional conditions, namely a structured system of impunity for murder, must be overcome.

The Assassinated Presidents Charles River Editors, 2025-05-01. Until April 14, 1865, John Wilkes Booth was one of the most famous actors of his time, and President Abraham Lincoln had even watched him perform. But his most significant performance at a theater did not take place on the stage. That night, Booth became one of history's most infamous assassins when he assassinated President Lincoln at Ford's Theatre in Washington, D.C. After the shooting, during which it is believed he broke his leg, Booth fled south on horseback with authorities hot on his tail. 12 days later, while he was at a farm in rural northern Virginia, Booth was tracked down and shot by Boston Corbett, a Union soldier who acted against orders. Eight others were tried for their alleged involvement in the plot and convicted, and four were hanged shortly thereafter as a result of some of the nation's most famous trials. In 1880, Garfield ran as a Republican for president, and one of his supporters was a man named Charles Guiteau, who wrote and circulated a speech called *Garfield vs. Hancock* that aimed to rally support for the Republican candidate. Though few knew it, Guiteau's family had already deemed him insane and attempted to keep him committed in an asylum only to have him manage an

escape from confinement Despite lobbying around Republican headquarters in New York City and even approaching Cabinet members no post was forthcoming for the troubled man Eventually in May 1881 Secretary of State James Blaine told him to never show up again Enraged by the perceived slight Guiteau bought a revolver and plotted to kill the president He got his chance on July 2 1881 at a railroad station shooting Garfield in the back twice and bragging to the authorities I am a Stalwart of the Stalwarts Arthur is president now President James Garfield had been assassinated just 20 years earlier but McKinley didn't worry about presidential security or his own safety and that was the case in Buffalo McKinley's insistence on greeting the public and shaking hands allowed Czolgosz to walk up to him on September 6 1901 at a public reception in the Temple of Music on the expo grounds and shoot him point blank with one bullet grazing the president and another lodging in his abdomen In the aftermath of the shooting as Czolgosz was beaten and seized by the crowd he uttered I done my duty For his part McKinley said He didn't know poor fellow what he was doing He couldn't have known Despite being president McKinley's medical services were shoddy and given the still primitive medical standards of the early 20th century gunshots to the abdomen often brought death One of the best known aspects of the assassination is that Thomas Edison's x-ray machine was on hand and may have been used to try to locate the bullet that doctors couldn't find but for reasons that remain unknown the x-ray machine was not used In many ways John Fitzgerald Kennedy and his young family were the perfect embodiment of the 60s The decade began with a sense of idealism personified by the attractive Kennedy his beautiful and fashionable wife Jackie and his young children Months into his presidency Kennedy exhorted the country to reach for the stars calling upon the nation to send a man to the Moon and back by the end of the decade In 1961 Kennedy made it seem like anything was possible and Americans were eager to believe him The Kennedy years were fondly and famously labeled Camelot by Jackie herself suggesting an almost mythical quality about the young President and his family As it turned out the 60s closely reflected the glossy idealistic portrayal of John F Kennedy as well as the uglier truths The country would achieve Kennedy's goal of a manned moon mission and the landmark Civil Rights Act of 1964 finally guaranteed minorities their civil rights and restored equality ensuring that the country would live out the true meaning of its creed
