Wachs, Robert Sheehan, 2013-06-29 Our knowledge of the cognitive and social emotional functioning of developmentally disabled infants and preschoolers derives in large part from our assessment of such children This book has been developed to familiarize readers with the characteristics of developmentally disabled children and to introduce to readers aspects of measurement that are of relevance to the assessment of atypical infants and preschoolers The book has been developed with clinicians and prospective clinicians in mind These are individuals who are committed to the care and education of developmentally disabled infants and preschoolers and the families of those children The book has thus been written to provide support for the use of assessment data in planning early intervention programs Of special note in the development of this edited book is that it is divided into four major parts with interrelated chapters in each part The authors of chapters in Parts II and III had access to the chapters in Part I before writing their chapters The summary chapters found in Part IV were similarly written by authors having access to all chapters in Parts I-III This approach to the development of an edited book was chosen as a way of ensuring an integration of major concepts throughout the book This process is also a reflection of our belief that assessment is an interdisciplinary process involving the synthesis of a number of diverse interests

Cognitive Development and Child Psychotherapy Stephen R. Shirk, 2013-11-09 Like hiking off the well traveled trail attempting to bridge foreign domains of research and practice entails certain risks This volume represents an effort to explore the relatively uncharted territory of cognitive and social cognitive processes embedded in child psychotherapy The territory is largely uncharted not because of a lack of interest in children and cognition but because child psychotherapy has been chronically neglected by clinical researchers For example recent meta analyses of the effectiveness of child psychotherapy draw on less than 30 non behavioral studies of child psychotherapy conducted over a 30 year period The average of one study per year pales in comparison to the volume of research on adult psychotherapy Moreover research examining cognitive affective and language processes in child psychotherapy is virtually nonexistent Consequently the contributions to this volume should not be seen as reviews of an extant clinical research literature Instead they represent attempts to expand the more familiar and well researched province of developmental psychology into the relatively uncharted domain of child psychotherapy process In addition to bridging the literature on child psychotherapy with research perspectives on children's cognitive and social cognitive development this volume attempts to cross a second gap Recent surveys of the utilization of psychotherapy research by practicing psychotherapists indicate the distance between these two domains is substantial Only a small minority of practitioners find psychotherapy research to be a useful source of information for their practice *National Library of Medicine Current Catalog* National Library of Medicine (U.S.),

Wachs, 1992-08-26 Are there certain periods in a child's development when he or she may be more sensitive to specific environmental influences than at earlier or later times Are preschool teachers equally nurturant to securely attached versus insecurely attached children Are girls more sensitive than boys to parental maltreatment Designed to synthesize what we know about the nature of environmental influences nurture upon development Wachs artfully explores whether development depends upon a sole factor the rearing environment genetics nutrition or individual characteristics or whether the degree of directional consistency combined with the extent of covariance among these factors may have the most developmental impact Issues such as how individuals respond differently to stress medical treatment parenting styles teaching approaches and daycare centers are all discussed through careful analysis of research and theories from a variety of fields Researchers teachers and intervention specialists of developmental psychology family studies social psychology education and nursing will find The Nature of Nurture an inspiration to further examine how environmental systems determine variability in developmental outcomes and what can be done to promote optimal outcomes for individual children
