



Checklists for Mentors and Mentees

Whether you are a mentor, or receiving mentoring – here is some guidance to help you. Check how far you meet the list. Please don't feel that you have to excel in every area from the start – you can refine your skills throughout your mentoring relationship.

Mentee's Checklist

As a mentee, take responsibility and ownership for your participation, learning and development by being prepared for each session. For best results:

- ☒ **Be clear about your mentoring objectives (big and small)** – know why you need a mentor (big picture) and what you need help with during each session (small). Your mentor needs to understand what you want from them.
- ☒ **Discuss what success will look like and how you will measure it** – how will you know when you have achieved your objectives?
- ☒ **Communicate** – make sure that your mentor understands your objectives and situation. It is up to you to communicate these to them.
- ☒ **Prepare** – before each session, decide what you want to discuss and bring discussion items to each session (e.g. challenges, situations, or questions).
- ☒ **Be honest and keep an open mind** – share your experiences; admit your weaknesses or needs. Be flexible to explore possibilities and find solutions.
- ☒ **Respect and consider** your mentor's advice, guidance, experience, knowledge and expertise – but do question, to broaden your thinking.
- ☒ **Expect constructive criticism or feedback** – feedback and challenge are good things. Only outside your comfort zone does true learning happen.
- ☒ **Review notes of previous meetings and actions agreed** – you're accountable for your own actions, so keep notes and take action to support your progress.
- ☒ **Ask for what you need** – if you are not getting what you need, or something is not going to plan – speak up and ask for what you need. This is a safe learning space to practise asking, negotiating, and experimenting.
- ☒ **Review and feedback** – Give feedback to your mentor on their mentoring input – thank them, say what went well, or what would be better/ more helpful.
