Culture and Power in South Asian Islam Nilesh Bose, 2017-10-02 This book explores the myriad diversities of South Asian Islam from a historical perspective attuned to the lived practices of Muslims in various portions of South Asia outside of Urdu Persian or Arabic language perspectives These perspectives are in some cases taken both from literal regions rarely noticed within discussions of South Asian Islam such as Sri Lanka Bengal and Tamil Nadu In other contributions the perspectives draw on historiographic interventions about the role of fakirs in South Asian history qasbahs in South Asian history and the role of Aligarh students within the Pakistan movement As a collection of voices aimed at stimulating debate about the range and diversity of South Asian Islam the book probes meanings and markers of categories like Indic Islamicate and local or global Islam within the context of South Asia Relevant to debates in the history of South Asia as well as Islamic studies this collection will serve as a reference point for discussions about South Asian Islam as well as the nature and role of vernacularization as a cultural process This book was originally published as a special issue of South Asian History and Culture

South Asia in Transition Robert Parkin, 2020-05-19 South Asia in Transition is an introductory book on the anthropology of South Asia including India Pakistan Nepal Sri Lanka and Bangladesh suitable for students at all levels and others interested in this topic It assumes no prior knowledge of either the region or the discipline of anthropology The book makes extensive use of existing publications to describe how anthropologists have approached the region and what they have said about it The first group of chapters deals mostly with India and caste class tribes religion kinship and marriage gender the body and personhood politics and political economy A second group of chapters deals successively with Pakistan Sri Lanka and Nepal

Indian Muslim(s) after Liberalization Maidul Islam, 2018-12-13 Close to the turn of the century and almost 45 years after Independence India opened its doors to free market liberalization Although meant as the promise to a better economic tomorrow three decades later many feel betrayed by the economic changes ushered in by this new financial era Here is a book that probes whether India s economic reforms have aided the development of Indian Muslims who have historically been denied the fruits of economic development Maidul Islam points out that in current political discourse the Muslim question in India is not articulated in

terms of demands for equity Instead the political leadership camouflages real issues of backwardness prejudice and social exclusion with the rhetoric of identity and security Historically informed empirically grounded and with robust analytical rigour the book tries to explore connections between multiple forms of Muslim marginalization the socio economic realities facing the community and the formation of modern Muslim identity in the country At a time when post liberalization economic policies have created economic inequality and joblessness for significant sections of the population including Muslims the book proposes working towards a radical democratic deepening in India

Revisiting Muslim Women's Activism Esita Sur, 2022-12-12 This book traces the evolution of organisational activism among Muslim women in India It deconstructs the Muslim woman as the monolith based on tropes like purdah polygamy and tin talaq and compels the reader to revisit the question of Muslim women's individual and collective agency The book argues that the political field along with religion moulds the nature and scope of Muslim women's activism in India It looks at the objectives of four Muslim women's organisations the Bazm e Niswan the Awaaz e Niswaan the Bharatiya Muslim Mahila Andolan and the India International Women's Alliance IWA in close interaction with the political landscape of Mumbai The book explores the emergence of gender inclusive interpretation of Muslim women's rights by Muslim women activists and challenges the dominant and reductionist stereotypes on Muslim women community and absolutist ideas of Islam It argues that Muslim women are not passive victims of their culture and religion rather they can develop a critique of their marginality and subjugation from within the community Revisiting Muslim Women's Activism traces the evolution of a community centric approach in women's activism and records a fragmented view on women's rights from within the community and religious leadership It also delineates the distinctiveness of this activism that considers religion and culture as resources for empowerment and as sites of contestations Moreover the book documents the narratives of Muslim women's struggle and resistance from their location and lived experiences It will be of interest to students and researchers of women's studies gender studies political science sociology anthropology law and Islamic studies

Buddhist Extremists and Muslim Minorities John Clifford Holt, 2016-09-30 When the civil war in Sri Lanka between Sinhala Buddhists and Tamils ended in 2009 many Sri Lankans and foreign observers alike hoped to see the re-establishment of relatively harmonious religious and ethnic relations among the various communities in the country Instead a different type of violence erupted this time aimed at the Muslim community The essays in Buddhist Extremists and Muslim Minorities investigate the history and current state of Buddhist Muslim relations in Sri Lanka in an attempt to identify the causes of this newly emergent conflict Euro American readers unfamiliar with this story will be surprised to learn that it inverts common stereotypes of the two religious groups In this context certain groups of Buddhists generally considered peace oriented in the West are engaged in victimizing Muslims who are increasingly seen as militant The authors examine the historical contexts and substantive reasons that gave rise to Buddhist nationalism and aggressive attacks on Muslim communities The rise of Buddhist nationalism in general is analyzed and explained while the

specific role methods and character of the militant Bodu Bala Sena Army of Buddhist Power movement receive particular scrutiny The motivations for attacks on Muslims may include deep seated perceptions of economic disparity but elements of religious culture ritual and symbol are also seen as catalysts for explosive acts of violence This much needed timely commentary promises to shift the standard narrative on Muslims and religious violence

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
