David Bergelson's Strange New World Harriet Murav,2019-02-01 David Bergelson 1884 1952 emerged as a major literary figure who wrote in Yiddish before WWI He was one of the founders of the Kiev Kultur Lige and his work was at the center of the Yiddish speaking world of the time He was well known for creating characters who often felt the painful after effects of the past and the clumsiness of bodies stumbling through the actions of daily life as their familiar worlds crumbled around them In this contemporary assessment of Bergelson and his fiction Harriet Murav focuses on untimeliness anachronism and warped temporality as an emotional sensory existential and historical background to Bergelson s work and world Murav grapples with the great modern theorists of time and memory especially Henri Bergson Sigmund Freud and Walter Benjamin to present Bergelson as an integral part of the philosophical and artistic experiments political and technological changes and cultural context of Russian and Yiddish modernism that marked his age As a comparative and interdisciplinary study of Yiddish literature and Jewish culture this work adds a new ethnic dimension to understandings of the turbulent birth of modernism

The Transgressionists and Other Disquieting Works Giorgio De Maria,2022-07-12 A disturbing unsettling novel if it had been published in English soon after its first appearance in Italian 1968 the name of Giorgio De Maria would be well known his novels and stories mentioned in the context of J G Ballard Anna Kavan Shirley Jackson or Robert Aickman Lisa Tuttle Nebula Award winner and author of Gabriel Windhaven and The Curious Affair of the Witch at Wayside Cross Before an untimely mental breakdown cut short his two decade career Giorgio De Maria distinguished himself as one of Italy s most unique and eccentric weird fiction masters With a background in the post war literary culture of Turin Italy s urbane but eerie city of black magic De Maria drew inspiration from the Turinese underbelly of occultism secret societies and radical politics His writing coincided with the decade of terrorist violence known to Italians as the Years of Lead the outcome was a weird fiction suffused with panic rage trauma paranoia and meditations on antisocial hubris In 1978 he told an interviewer I think that the dimension of the fantastic as much as this may seem paradoxical is the most fitting one to express a reality as complex as ours today De Maria s debut novel The Transgressionists

1968 portrays a cell of malicious telepaths who meet in the cafés and jazz clubs of 1960s Turin to plot world domination After experiencing the worst of their power an embittered office clerk resolves to join them and prove himself worthy to share in their villainy He cultivates twisted mindfulness techniques to awaken his inner sociopath He fights off predatory phantoms that seem maddeningly drawn to him He prepares for the dangerous Great Leap which will make him into a fully fledged Transgressionist But could his megalomania strain relations with his fiancée Will he sacrifice love in his quest for omnipotence The other works in this volume are no less surreal and startling The Secret Death of Joseph Dzhughashvili 1976 gives us a nightmarish fantasy Soviet Union where a dissident poet finds himself trapped in a psychological experiment conducted by Stalin himself In The End of Everydayism a group of futuristic artists begin using corpses as a medium with violent unforeseen results The antihero of General Trebisonda is a possibly insane commander who prepares for a war crime in an eerily deserted fortress Available in English for the first time this collection contains two novellas two short stories and a dystopian teleplay The Appeal which the post cyberpunk novelist Andrea Vaccaro has lauded as worthy of the best episodes of Black Mirror Meanwhile an introduction by translator Ramon Glazov offers a detailed account of De Maria's background creative context and thoroughly unusual life

Climate Trauma E. Ann Kaplan, 2015-12-04 Each month brings new scientific findings that demonstrate the ways in which human activities from resource extraction to carbon emissions are doing unprecedented perhaps irreparable damage to our world As we hear these climate change reports and their predictions for the future of Earth many of us feel a sickening sense of déjà vu as though we have already seen the sad outcome to this story Drawing from recent scholarship that analyzes climate change as a form of slow violence that humans are inflicting on the environment Climate Trauma theorizes that such violence is accompanied by its own psychological condition what its author terms Pretraumatic Stress Disorder Examining a variety of films that imagine a dystopian future renowned media scholar E Ann Kaplan considers how the increasing ubiquity of these works has exacerbated our sense of impending dread But she also explores ways these films might help us productively engage with our anxieties giving us a seemingly prophetic glimpse of the terrifying future selves we might still work to avoid becoming Examining dystopian classics like Soylent Green alongside more recent examples like The Book of Eli Climate Trauma also stretches the limits of the genre to include features such as Blindness The Happening Take Shelter and a number of documentaries on climate change These eclectic texts allow Kaplan to outline the typical blind spots of the genre which rarely depicts climate catastrophe from the vantage point of women or minorities Lucidly synthesizing cutting edge research in media studies psychoanalytic theory and environmental science Climate Trauma provides us with the tools we need to extract something useful from our nightmares of a catastrophic future

Mc Cormack, 2016-03-01 Enigmas of Sacrifice A Critique of Joseph M Plunkett and the Dublin Insurrection of 1916 is the first critical study of the religious poet and militarist Joseph M Plunkett who was executed with the other leaders of the Dublin insurrection of 1916 Through Plunkett the author gains access to areas of nationalist thought that were more often assumed or repressed than publicly formulated In this eye opening book W J Mc Cormack explores and analyzes Plunkett's brief life work and influence beginning with his wealthy but dysfunctional family irregular Jesuit education and self canceling sexuality Mc Cormack continues through Plunkett's active phase when amateur theatricals and a magazine editorship brought him into the emergent neonationalist discourse of early twentieth century Ireland Finally the author arrives at Holy Week 1916 when Plunkett masterminded the forgery of official documentation in order to provoke and justify the insurrection he planned Mc Cormack analyzes Plunkett's significant texts and provides context through critical perspectives on his milieu Enigmas of Sacrifice is unique in its effort to understand a major figure of Irish nationalism in terms that reach beyond political identity
