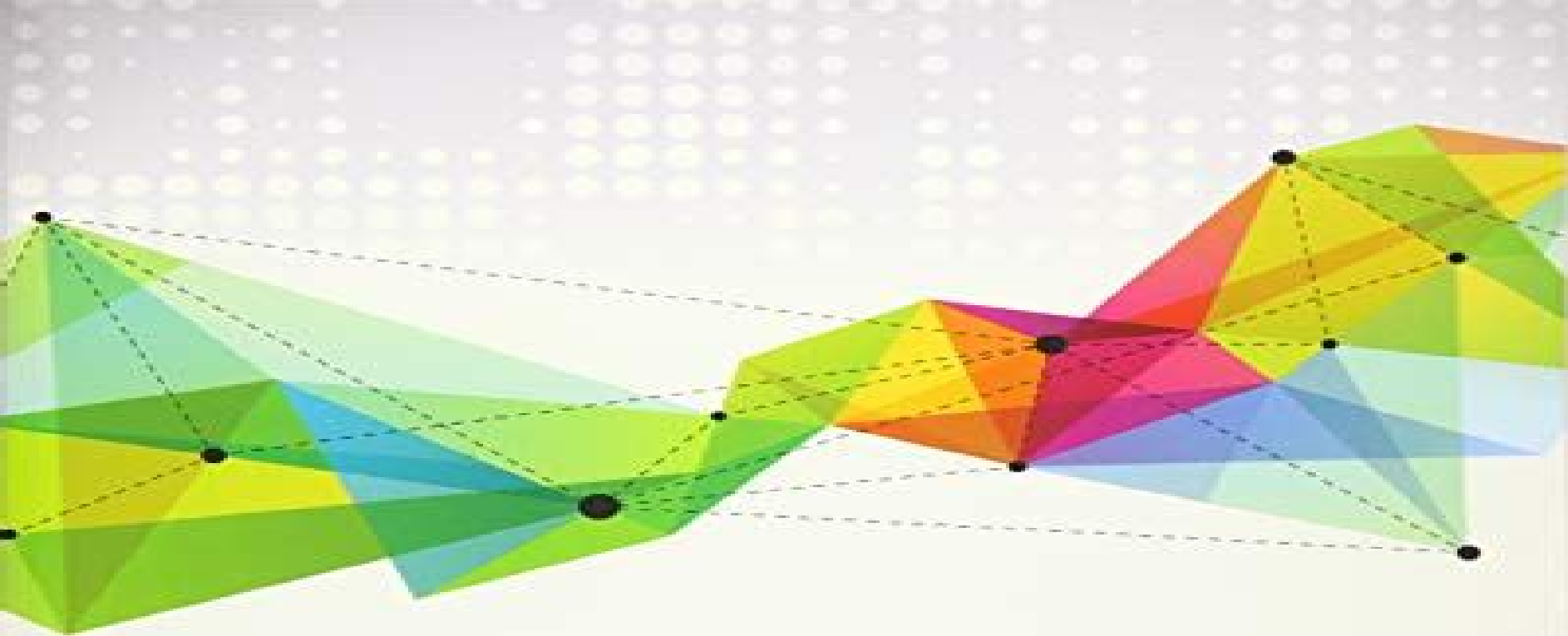




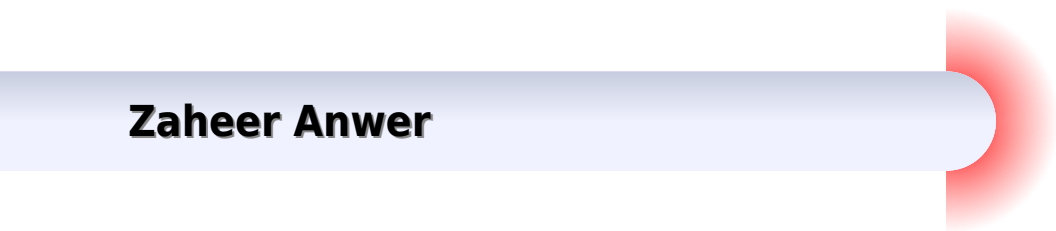

Statistical Methods for Experimental Research in Education and Psychology Jimmie Leppink, 2019-05-30 This book focuses on experimental research in two disciplines that have a lot of common ground in terms of theory experimental designs used and methods for the analysis of experimental research data education and psychology Although the methods covered in this book are also frequently used in many other disciplines including sociology and medicine the examples in this book come from contemporary research topics in education and psychology Various statistical packages commercial and zero cost Open Source ones are used The goal of this book is neither to cover all possible statistical methods out there nor to focus on a particular statistical software package There are many excellent statistics textbooks on the market that present both basic and advanced concepts at an introductory level and or provide a very detailed overview of options in a particular statistical software programme This is not yet another book in that genre Core theme of this book is a heuristic called the question design analysis bridge there is a bridge connecting research questions and hypotheses experimental design and sampling procedures and common statistical methods in that context Each statistical method is discussed in a concrete context of a set of research question with directed one sided or undirected two sided hypotheses and

an experimental setup in line with these questions and hypotheses Therefore the titles of the chapters in this book do not include any names of statistical methods such as analysis of variance or analysis of covariance In a total of seventeen chapters this book covers a wide range of topics of research questions that call for experimental designs and statistical methods fairly basic or more advanced

Islamic Banking Hasan Gürak,Neelambar Hatti,2024-03-12 The issue of riba that is interest the excess or surplus on loans is crucial for both Islamic and non Islamic countries Western economic systems use interest to distribute financial resources efficiently for investment and or consumption while Islamic economies pursue a completely different strategy for financing loans which adheres to Islamic laws and prohibits the activities of conventional banking systems with regard to interest This book argues that there is scope for new definitions and analysis based on alternative concepts which respect Islamic values and principles yet pave the way for modification and debate The book comprises of two parts Theoretical issues are dealt with in the first section The first two chapters examine conventional Islamic views on the prohibition of riba while Chapters 3

and 4 contain unprecedented and alternative theoretical analysis based on concepts such as earned halal permitted legal vs unearned haram impermissible illegal income and SUKUK that is Islamic interest free bonds The second part of the book tackles another unconventional aspect of Islamic finance that is the concept of NAS The book considers whether the NAS influenced anti inflationary interest policy was a success or failure Empirical data is evaluated in terms of bank incomes inflation rate interest rate and the distribution of income This book will be a useful guide for students scholars and researchers of Islamic banking and finance

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
