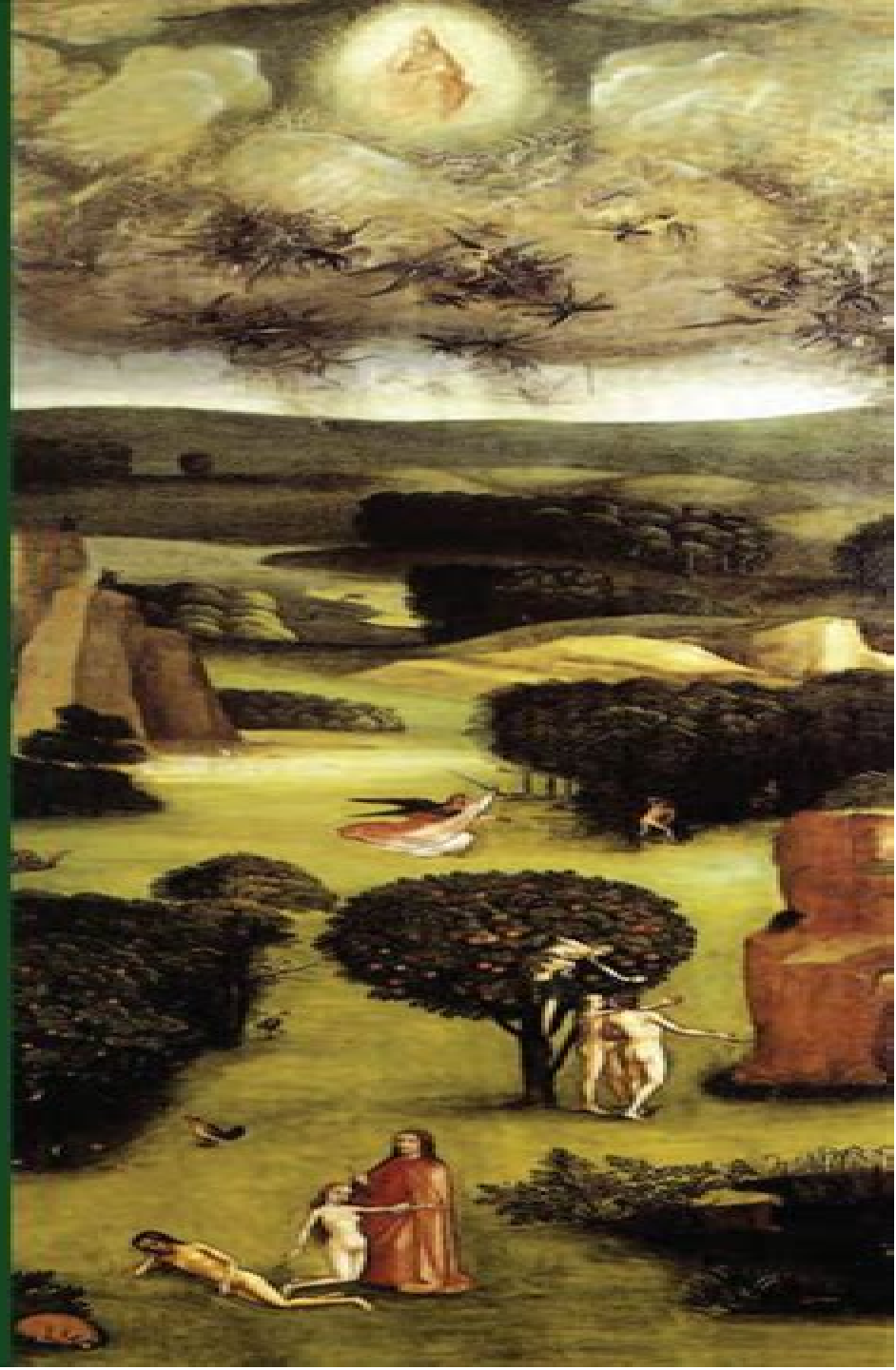

Adam as Israel Seth D Postell, 2012-04-26 Postell contends that the opening chapters of the Bible when interpreted as a strategic literary introduction to the Torah and to the Tanakh intentionally foreshadows Israel's failure to keep the Sinai Covenant and their consequent exile from the Promised Land in order to point the reader to a future work of God Postell highlights numerous intentional links between the story of Adam and the story of Israel and in the process explains numerous otherwise perplexing features of the Eden story Postell employs a wealth of theologies to support his argument including those of Nicholas of Lyra John Calvin Wellhausen Johannes Coccejus and Matthew Poole successfully breathing new life into the wealth of exegeses

The Testing of God's Sons Gregory S. Smith, 2014-05 There exists a general lack of biblical understanding for the idea of testing that emerges in the Old Testament as a significant theological theme The faithful from both Old Testament and New Testament times are tested for their faith This kind of experience often involves enduring hardship and difficult times While often confused with the biblical idea of temptation the biblical idea of testing stems from a metallurgical background and carries a unique covenantal function Testing will be at the center of how God responds to the rebellion of his people and reveals God's primary concern for the faith of his saints Our study will first focus on the language of testing and explore the semantic range for the idea of testing that draws from both the biblical context as well as the world of the ancient Near East This study will then focus on the often overlooked Joseph narrative and its unique contribution to the theology of testing that is presented by the rest of the Pentateuch Finally the remainder of the biblical texts will be investigated on the theme of testing The last chapter will appreciate the fact that God tests His sons Adam Abraham Joseph Moses Job Israel and even Christ It is through the experience of God's tested sons that believers are invited to more fully and deeply understand their own experience of testing

The Fall Reconsidered Igal German, 2016-05-27 The sin narratives of Genesis 3 and 4 have been scrutinized by biblical interpreters throughout the centuries Some exegetical traditions have separated the story of Cain Abel from the preceding Edenic narrative thus undermining the unity of the Primeval History The book synthesizes the sin narratives of Adam Eve and Cain Abel and examines a wide range of premodern biblical interpretations attesting to their literary and theological unity This study makes a case for reading these primordial narratives as one familial saga that conveys to the reader the origins of human defiance against God

A New Look at Atonement in Leviticus James A. Greenberg, 2020-05-11 In this book James A Greenberg examines animal sacrifice in Priestly Torah texts found in Leviticus 1 16 Exodus and Numbers Through his analysis Greenberg identifies a new valence of kipper as a process that produces a positive result between two objects and argues that the Israelite sanctuary exists to facilitate a connection between YHWH sancta and the Israelites through the medium of blood Rather than beginning with a priori assumptions of what sacrificial terms and symbols mean Greenberg allows his interpretation to develop through an accumulation of textual clues To avoid the exegetical pitfalls of symbolic and structuralist approaches he focuses on what the

language of the ritual says about sacrifice and what it seeks to accomplish His investigation considers why the flesh and blood of an animal are used by the priest as he mediates on behalf of the offerer through the medium of YHWH s sanctuary what the difference is between intentional and unintentional sin how the meaning of kipper changes from one sacrifice to the next whether the sanctuary can be both holy and unclean and how priests conceive of YHWH s interaction with sancta the offerer and the animal A New Look at Atonement in Leviticus recalibrates our understanding of kipper and furthers our knowledge of the priestly cult in ancient Israel It will especially interest scholars of Biblical Hebrew and the Old Testament in particular

The Generations of Heaven and Earth Jon Garvey, 2020-01-21 New science has surprised many by showing contrary to received wisdom that a real Adam and Eve could have lived amongst other humans in historical times and yet be the ancestors of every living person as traditional Christianity has always taught This theory was first published in book form in 2019 but Jon Garvey familiar with it from its early days believes it helps confirm the Christian account of reality by giving it a solid foundation in science and history In this book he argues that the long existence of other people before and alongside Adam was in all likelihood known to the Bible s original authors This conclusion helps build a compelling biblical big story of a new kind of created order initially frustrated by Adam s failure but finally accomplished in Christ This new creation theme complements that of the old creation covered in his first book God s Good Earth The two together contribute to a unified and fully orthodox
