

4. As reported by Marcellus, what has Horatio said about “this thing” which has appeared before CL28-301? Explain in your own words.

Marcellus says, “Horatio says ‘tis but our fantasy / And will not let belief take hold of him / Touching this dreaded sight twice-seen of us (CL28-301). In other words, Horatio is there to see for himself as he doesn’t believe the reports.

5. Bernardo says to Horatio, “Let us once again assail your ears, / That are so fortified against our story (CL37-38). Unpack this metaphor. What does “assail” mean? What does “fortified” mean? What is the general tone created by this figurative language?

The word “assail” means to violently attack and the word “fortified” suggests a place that has been strengthened against attack. The tone is one of danger and uncertainty. In short, the feeling and danger of war is prevalent even in a verbal exchange between two people who are on the same side.

6. When he sees the ghost, Horatio says “It harrows me with fear and wonder” (L33). See the notes for the word “harrow.” What is suggested by this metaphor?

If you are using the Folger’s addition of the play, there is a great note with an image of a harrow which was a tool with sharp spines that was used to plow. In short, Horatio feels like he is being plowed with fear and wonder. Sounds painful!

7. Horatio also describes the ghost as having “that fair and warlike form / In which the majesty of buried Denmark / Did sometimes march” (L35-37). In other words, the ghost appears in the afterlife as he did when he went into battle when he was alive. What is Shakespeare suggesting about the afterlife with this choice?

If the king is wearing armor in the afterlife, this suggests that it is as dangerous as if he were going into battle. In other words, it’s not a safe or pleasant place.

8. Horatio says of the ghost’s appearance, “This bodes some strange eruption to our state” (L80, l. 1. What point is he making? Explain in your own words.

“Bode” means to forecast or prophesy. And the word “eruption” suggests an explosion or sudden outbreak. In other words, Horatio is saying that the appearance of the dead king as a ghost suggests that something destructive will happen or is happening to the government or country.

9. As explained by Marcellus and Horatio, Denmark is gearing up for an attack by Norway, headed by Fortinbras who wants to forcefully take back the land that was lost by his father. Explain in your own words how it would feel to be living in a country in this situation.

Students’ answers will vary; keep the discussion going until they have brought up a few different responses. They might say that inhabitants of the country would feel scared, nervous, maybe a little excited for a battle. They would likely be hoping that their rulers will protect them from this threat.
