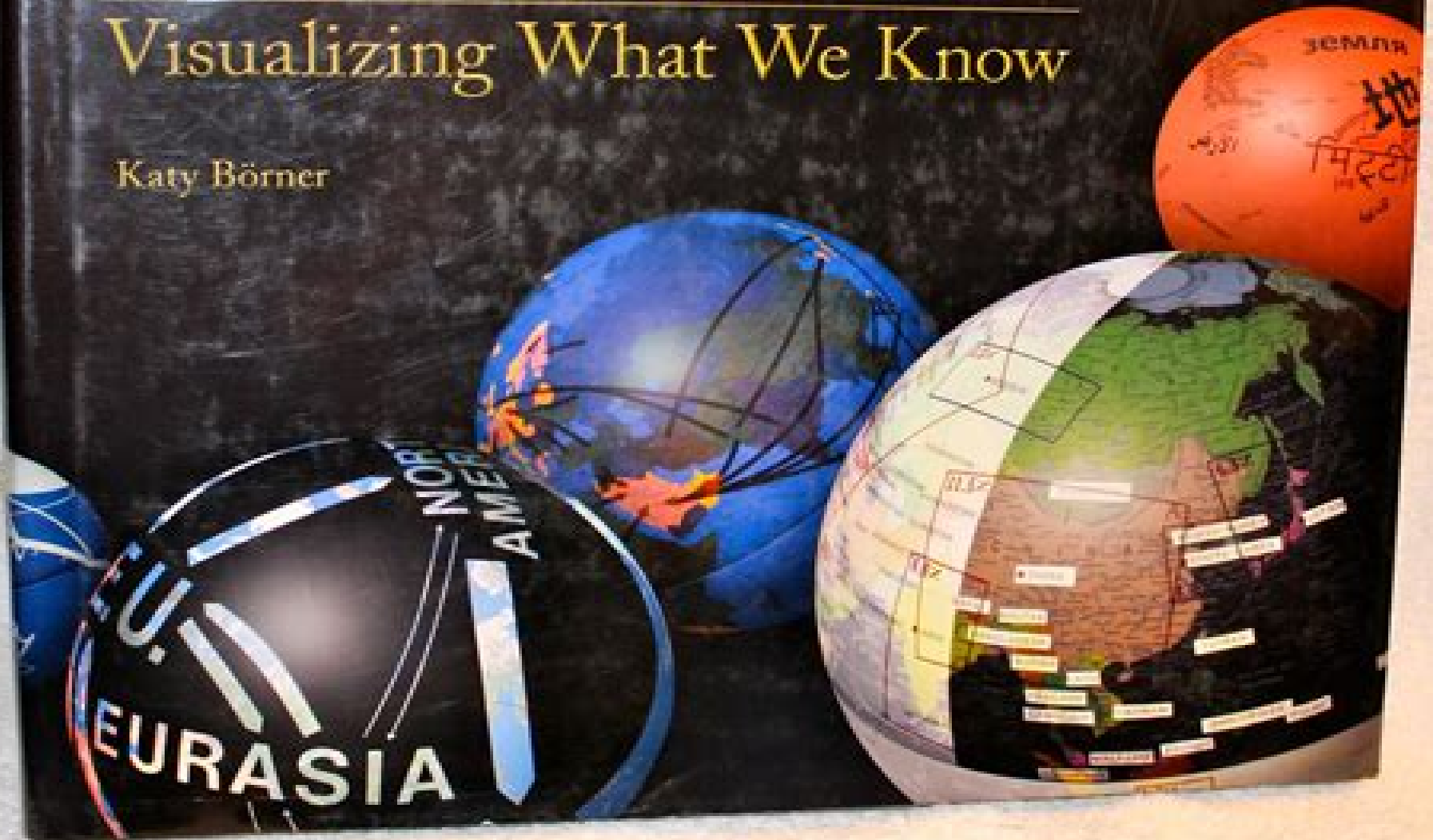

interactive possibilities in mind in other words designing to support a human information interactive discourse This is especially true in contexts where interactive visualizations need to support complex tasks and activities involving large and complex information spaces The framework is intended to be general and can thus be used to design visualizations for diverse domains users information spaces and tasks in different fields such as business intelligence health and medical informatics digital libraries journalism education scientific discovery and others Drawing from research in multiple disciplines we introduce novel concepts and terms that can positively contribute to visualization design practice and education and will hopefully stimulate further research in this area
