Jackson, 2002-01-01 When Egypt became a province of the Roman Empire in 30 BC after the deaths of Antony and Cleopatra its vast and mysterious frontier lands had an important impact on the commerce politics and culture of the empire This account part history and part gazetteer focuses on Rome s Egyptian frontier describing the ancient fortresses temples settlements quarries and aqueducts scattered throughout the region and conveying a sense of what life was like for its inhabitants Robert Jackson has journeyed by jeep and on foot to virtually every known Roman site in the area from Siwa Oasis 45 kilometers from the modern Libyan border to the Sudan Drawing on both archaeological and historical information he discusses these sites explaining how Rome extracted exotic stone and precious metals from the mountains of the Eastern Desert channelled the wealth of India and East Africa through the desert via ports on the Red Sea constructed and manned fortresses in the distant oases of the Western Desert and facilitated the expansion of agricultural communities in the desert that eventually experienced the earliest large scale conversions to Christianity in Egypt Illustrated with many photographs the volume should be useful to archaeologists classicists and travellers to the region

Roads in the Deserts of Roman Egypt Maciej Paprocki, 2019-07-19 Egypt under the Romans 30 BCE 3rd century CE was a period when local deserts experienced an unprecedented flurry of activity In the Eastern Desert a marked increase in desert traffic came from imperial prospecting quarrying activities and caravans transporting wares to and from the Red Sea ports In the Western Desert resilient camels slowly became primary beasts of burden in desert travel enabling caravaneers to lengthen daily marching distances across previously inhospitable dunes Desert road archaeology has used satellite imaging landscape studies and network analysis to plot desert trail networks with greater accuracy however it is often difficult to date roadside installations and thus assess how these networks evolved in scope and density in reaction to climatic social and technological change Roads in the Deserts of Roman Egypt examines evidence for desert roads in Roman Egypt and assesses Roman influence on the road density in two select desert areas the central and southern section of the Eastern Desert and the central Marmarican Plateau and discusses geographical and social factors influencing road use in the period demonstrating that Roman overseers of these lands adapted remarkably well to local desert conditions improving roads and developing the trail network Crucially the author reconceptualises desert trails as linear corridor structures that follow expedient routes in the desert landscape passing through at least two functional nodes attracting human traffic be those water sources farmlands mines quarries trade hubs military installations or actual settlements The route of least resistance across the desert varied from period to period according to the available road infrastructure and beasts of burden employed Roman administration in Egypt not only increased the density of local desert node networks but also facilitated internodal connections with camel caravans and transformed the Sahara by establishing new or embellishing existing nodes effectively funnelling desert traffic into discernible corridors Significantly not all desert areas of Egypt are equally suited for
