Concord - An early battle of the American Revolution was fought in Concord, a town in eastern Massachusetts.

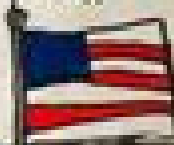
Daughters of Liberty - Women who displayed their loyalty by participating in boycotts of British goods.

Lexington - It was the battle that started the Revolutionary War. It was one of the very first battles along with Concord. The Americans won.

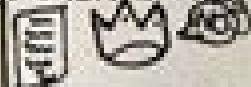
Mary Otis Warren - She wrote the first history of the Revolutionary War. She also wrote plays making fun of the British.

Rear Act - Called the Sugar and Molasses Act, it changed the price of molasses from 10 pence to three pence.

Treaty of Paris - Negotiated between the United States and Great Britain, it ended the Revolutionary war and recognized America as a free country.

United States of America - The land that we won from Britain after the Revolutionary war. Eventually, over the centuries, we got more and more of the United States.

Valley Forge - In Pennsylvania, the site of the military camp over the winter of 1777-78.



Washington, George - Leader of the Continental Army and first president of the United States.
