Strengthening the Responsibility to Protect Richard Illingworth, 2023-11-02 This book provides a systematic analysis of reform measures aimed at strengthening the implementation of the Responsibility to Protect R2P doctrine utilising a cosmopolitan lens In 2005 member states of the United Nations UN accepted a Responsibility to Protect against four mass atrocity crimes genocide crimes against humanity war crimes and ethnic cleansing Despite this commitment mass atrocities remain a pervasive aspect of the international landscape In addressing R2P reform the book utilises a transitional cosmopolitan lens The aim of this transitional cosmopolitan approach is to promote incremental progress towards solving moral problems by operating within particular contexts and practical barriers to change Three areas for reform are explored the UN Security Council P5 s power of veto to prevent the veto obstructing timely and decisive R2P response action the powers of the UN General Assembly as an alternative means for responding to mass atrocity situations and the establishment of an R2P Commission to hold states accountable for their R2P commitments These are not advocated as the definitive areas for R2P reform However each of the recommendations made can contribute at least some positive progress towards a more cosmopolitan application of the R2P that would help in curbing mass atrocity and improving the protection of fundamental human rights This book will be of much interest to students of the Responsibility to Protect genocide humanitarian protection and International Relations in general

Reconstructing the Responsibility to Protect Michael J. Butler, 2024-11-11 This book revisits and interrogates the evolution of the Responsibility to Protect in search of the root cause of R2P s failure to date Employing a critical constructivist lens throughout the book locates the origin of that apparent failure in the close association of R2P with humanitarian intervention In returning to the ideational underpinnings and broader ambitions of R2P s architects the analysis reveals that reducing R2P to little more than a solution to the long standing problem s confronting humanitarian intervention betrayed its fundamental purpose advancing a new norm of and for human security provision Employing a modified version of the norm life cycle model as a diagnostic tool the author uncovers the underlying dynamics of R2P s normative stagnation over the past two decades The book concludes with a prescriptive remedy in the form of a two part blueprint for reconstructing and reanimating R2P s normative agenda for an international society confronted by mounting and existential threats to humanity This book will be of much interest to scholars and students of the Responsibility to Protect human rights security studies and international relations in general

Sovereignty and the Responsibility to Protect Theresa Reinold, 2013 This book explores how the bedrock institution of today's global order sovereignty is undergoing transformation as a result of complex interactions between power and norms between politics and international law This book analyses a series of controversial military interventions into the internal affairs of irresponsible sovereigns and discusses their consequences for the rules on the use of force and the principle of sovereign equality Featuring case studies on Kosovo Darfur and Afghanistan It shows that frames from one discourse for example the debate over the responsibility to protect have been imported into other discourses on counter terrorism and nuclear non proliferation in an attempt to legitimize a bold challenge to the global legal order Although the demise of sovereignty is widely debated this book instead seeks to deconstruct sovereignty by explaining how this institution has been reconstituted by global powers whose hegemonic law making activities have popularized the notion of sovereignty as responsibility Drawing on international relations theory international law and sociology **Sovereignty and the Responsibility to Protect** develops a truly interdisciplinary perspective on the transformation of sovereignty and will be of strong interest to students and scholars in these fields

The Responsibility to Protect in International Law Natalie Oman, 2019-12-06 This book tracks the development of the emerging international legal principle of a responsibility to protect over the past two decades It contrasts the influential version of the principle introduced by the International Commission on Intervention and State Sovereignty in 2001 with subsequent interpretations of the responsibility to protect advocated by the United Nations through its human protection agenda and reviews the dangers and inconsistencies inherent in both perspectives The author demonstrates that the evolving responsibility to protect principle can be recruited to support a wide range of irreconcilable projects from those of cosmopolitan constitutionalism to those of hegemonic international law However despite the dangers posed by this susceptibility to conceptual hijacking Oman argues that the responsibility to protect like human rights is an essential a modern emancipatory formation To remedy this dangerous malleability the author advocates a third distinctive interpretation of the responsibility to protect designed to limit its cooptation by liberal anti pluralist and hegemonic international law agendas Oman outlines the key features of such a minimalist conception and explores its fit with the RtoP version of the responsibility to protect promoted in recent years by the UN The author argues that two crucial features missing from the

UN reading of the principle should be developed in future an acknowledgement of the role of non state actors as bearers of the responsibility to protect and a recognition of the principle s legal character Both of these aspects of the principle offer means to democratize the international law making enterprise

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
